## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5284

A bill to amend 1980 PA 299, entitled "Occupational code,"

by amending sections 2404 and 2405 (MCL 339.2404 and 339.2405), section 2404 as amended by 2010 PA 151 and section 2405 as amended by 2007 PA 157, and by adding section 2404c.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2404. (1) The EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 2404C, THE
- 2 department may require an applicant, A licensee, or each partner,
- 3 trustee, director, officer, member, or shareholder OF AN APPLICANT
- 4 OR LICENSEE to submit evidence of good moral character. , and
- 5 financial stability. Before the issuance of DEPARTMENT ISSUES a
- 6 license, an applicant shall submit a copy of an HIS OR HER
- 7 operator's license or state personal identification card —to be

- 1 used by the department. THE DEPARTMENT MAY USE THE LICENSE OR CARD
- 2 only for proof of identity of the applicant.
- 3 (2) The EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 2404C, THE department
- 4 shall require THAT an applicant for a license to UNDER THIS ARTICLE
- 5 pass an examination establishing THAT ESTABLISHES that the
- 6 applicant has a fair knowledge of the obligations of a residential
- 7 builder or residential maintenance and alteration contractor to the
- 8 public and the applicant's principal, and the statutes relating to
- 9 the applicant's licensure.
- 10 (3) The EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 2404C, THE department 7
- 11 upon application, may issue a residential maintenance and
- 12 alteration contractor's license to an applicant who, upon
- 13 examination, AN INDIVIDUAL WHO APPLIES FOR THE LICENSE AND WHO
- 14 qualifies for a THE license , which BY PASSING THE EXAMINATION. A
- 15 LICENSE authorizes the licensee, according to the applicant's
- 16 qualifications, crafts, and trades, to engage in the activities of
- 17 a residential maintenance and alteration contractor. A license
- 18 includes the following crafts and trades: carpentry; concrete;
- 19 swimming pool installation; waterproofing a basement; excavation;
- 20 insulation work; masonry work; painting and decorating; roofing;
- 21 siding and gutters; screen or storm sash installation; tile and
- 22 marble work; and house wrecking. The A license shall specify the
- 23 particular craft or trade for which the licensee has IS qualified.
- 24 This subsection does not prohibit a specialty contractor from
- 25 taking and executing a contract involving the use of 2 PERFORMANCE
- 26 OF THE CRAFT OR TRADE FOR WHICH THE CONTRACTOR HOLDS A LICENSE AND
- 27 1 or more OTHER crafts or trades if the performance of the work in

- 1 the OTHER craft or trade other than the craft for which the person
- 2 is licensed is incidental and supplemental to the performance of
- 3 work in the craft OR TRADE for which the specialty contractor is
- 4 licensed.
- 5 (4) A residential builder or residential maintenance and
- 6 alteration contractor shall maintain a place of business in this
- 7 state. If a residential builder or residential maintenance and
- 8 alteration contractor maintains more than 1 place of business
- 9 within IN this state, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE a branch office
- 10 license shall be issued to the builder or contractor for each place
- 11 of business so maintained BY THE BUILDER OR CONTRACTOR.
- 12 (5) Beginning the license cycle after December 21, 2007, the
- 13 THE department shall issue the license of a residential builder and
- 14 residential maintenance and alteration contractor for a period of 3
- 15 years in duration. Beginning December 21, 2007, an

- 19 residential code and has fulfilled MEETS the appropriate

- 22 (7) (6) Beginning December 21, 2007, a A licensee shall
- 23 maintain documentation, for at least 5 years, of activities meeting
- 24 THAT MEET the continuing competency requirements as prescribed
- 25 under this article.
- 26 SEC. 2404C. ALL OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS
- 27 APPLYING FOR A LICENSE OR RELICENSURE AS A RESIDENTIAL BUILDER OR

- 1 RESIDENTIAL MAINTENANCE AND ALTERATION CONTRACTOR, WHO WAS A

- 10 2404(1) CONCERNING THE GOOD MORAL CHARACTER OF THE APPLICANT AND
- 11 OTHER PERSONS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 2404(1), SHALL DETERMINE WHETHER
- 12 THE APPLICANT IS REQUIRED TO PASS AN EXAMINATION UNDER SECTION
- 13 2404(2) OR (3) OR 2405(1), AND MAY REQUIRE THAT THE APPLICANT MEET

- 15 (C) THE APPLICANT SHALL CERTIFY THAT HE OR SHE SUCCESSFULLY
- 16 COMPLETED AT LEAST 3 HOURS OF ACTIVITIES THAT DEMONSTRATE
- 17 CONTINUING COMPETENCY, THAT INCLUDE 1 HOUR OF CODES, 1 HOUR OF
- 18 SAFETY, AND 1 HOUR OF LEGAL ISSUES DESCRIBED IN SECTION 2404B(2),
- 19 IN THE 12 MONTHS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE DATE OF APPLICATION.
- 20 Sec. 2405. (1) If a license is applied for by SUBJECT TO
- 21 SECTION 2404C, IF a corporation, partnership, association, limited
- 22 liability company, or other entity APPLIES FOR A LICENSE, the
- 23 applicant shall designate 1 of its officers, partners, OR members T
- 24 or ITS managing agent as a qualifying officer. who, upon taking and

- 26 (2) The license of a corporation, partnership, association,
- 27 limited liability company, or other entity shall be IS suspended

- 1 when a license or license application of a qualifying officer,
- 2 partner, trustee, director, officer, OR member, or a person
- 3 exercising THAT EXERCISES control of the corporation, partnership,
- 4 association, limited liability company, or other entity, is
- 5 suspended, revoked, or denied. The suspension shall remain in force
- 6 until the board determines that the disability created by the
- 7 suspension, revocation, or denial has been IS removed.
- 8 (3) A suspension, revocation, or denial of a license of an
- 9 individual shall suspend, revoke, or deny any other license held or
- 10 applied for by that individual issued under this article. A
- 11 suspension, revocation, or denial of a license by the department
- 12 shall suspend, revoke, or deny any other license held or applied
- 13 for under this article by the qualifying officer IF AN INDIVIDUAL'S
- 14 LICENSE UNDER THIS ARTICLE IS SUSPENDED, REVOKED, OR DENIED BY THE
- 15 BOARD, ANY OTHER LICENSE ISSUED OR APPLIED FOR UNDER THIS ARTICLE
- 16 IS SUSPENDED, REVOKED, OR DENIED. IF THE LICENSE of a corporation,
- 17 partnership, association, limited liability company, or other
- 18 entity whose license is suspended, revoked, or denied, ANY OTHER
- 19 LICENSE ISSUED TO OR APPLIED FOR BY THE QUALIFYING OFFICER OF THAT
- 20 ENTITY IS SUSPENDED, REVOKED, OR DENIED.
- 21 (4) If the qualifying officer of a licensee ceases to be its
- 22 qualifying officer, the license is suspended. However, upon ON
- 23 request, the department may permit the license to remain in force
- 24 for a reasonable time to permit the qualification of a new
- 25 qualifying officer.
- 26 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 27 unless House Bill No. 4582 of the 97th Legislature is enacted into

1 law.
