## HOUSE BILL NO. 5418

A bill to authorize private employers to adopt and apply a veterans' preference employment policy.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "private employer's veterans' preference policy act".
- 3 (2) As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Private employer" means a sole proprietor, corporation,
- 5 partnership, limited liability company, or other private entity
- 6 with 1 or more employees.
- 7 (b) "Veteran" means an individual who meets 1 or more of the
- 8 following:
- 9 (i) Has served on active duty with the armed forces of the
- 10 United States for a period of more than 180 days and was discharged
- 11 or released from active duty with other than a dishonorable

- 1 discharge.
- 2 (ii) Was discharged or released from active duty with the armed
- 3 forces of the United States because of a service-connected
- 4 disability.
- 5 (iii) Was discharged or released from duty with other than a
- 6 dishonorable discharge from service as a member of a reserve or
- 7 national guard component of the armed forces of the United States
- 8 under an order to active duty, excluding active duty for training.
- 9 (c) "Veterans' preference employment policy" means a private
- 10 employer's voluntary preference for hiring, promoting, or retaining
- 11 a veteran over another equally qualified applicant or employee.
- Sec. 2. (1) A private employer may adopt and apply a voluntary
- 13 veterans' preference employment policy.
- 14 (2) A veterans' preference employment policy shall be in
- writing and shall be applied uniformly to employment decisions
- 16 regarding the hiring or promotion of veterans or the retention of
- 17 veterans during a reduction in the workforce.
