## HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 237

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 9208 (MCL 333.9208), as amended by 2000 PA 90.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 9208. (1) A parent, guardian, or person in loco parentis
- 2 applying to have a child registered for the first time in a school
- 3 in this state and, beginning in 2002-2003, JANUARY 1, 2014, a
- 4 parent, guardian, or person in loco parentis of a child entering
- 5 the sixth SEVENTH grade, shall present to school officials, at the
- 6 time of registration or not later than the first day of school, a
- 7 certificate of immunization or statement of exemption under section
- **8** 9215.
- 9 (2) A teacher or principal shall not permit a child to enter

- 1 or attend school unless a certificate indicating that a minimum of
- 2 1 dose of an immunizing agent against each of the diseases
- 3 specified by the department has been received and certified to by a
- 4 health professional or local health department. A parent, guardian,
- 5 or person in loco parentis having a child registered with only
- 6 these minimum doses of immunizing agents shall present an updated
- 7 certificate of immunization within 4 months after initial
- 8 attendance showing that the immunizations have been completed as
- 9 prescribed by the department.
- 10 (3) THE DEPARTMENT ANNUALLY SHALL PROVIDE A REPORT SHOWING A
- 11 YEAR-TO-YEAR COMPARISON OF THE PERCENTAGE OF CHILDREN BY AGE WHO
- 12 ARE IMMUNIZED APPROPRIATELY UPON ENTERING THE SEVENTH GRADE.
- 13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect July 1,
- **14** 2013.
- 15 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 16 unless all of the following bills of the 97th Legislature are
- 17 enacted into law:
