HOUSE BILL No. 4574

April 17, 2013, Introduced by Rep. Kurtz and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1980 PA 299, entitled "Occupational code,"

by amending section 1806 (MCL 339.1806), as amended by 1988 PA 463.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1806. (1) The department shall issue a license to engage
 in the practice of mortuary science to an individual who has MEETS
- 3 ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

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- (A) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (2), served as a resident trainee for 1 year under the personal supervision and instruction of the holder of a license for the practice of mortuary science. , has graduated
- (B) GRADUATED from a 3-year course in mortuary science in an accredited school, college, or university. , has

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- 1 (C) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (2), satisfactorily passed the
- 2 PASSES AN examination approved by the department and the board. τ
- 3 and is
- 4 (D) IS of good moral character. The
- 5 (2) AN applicant may take the examination DESCRIBED IN
- 6 SUBSECTION (1)(C) in 2 parts, 1 part after the completion of the
- 7 prescribed education and 1 part after the completion of the
- 8 prescribed education and the service of resident training. The
- 9 department may waive a portion of the requirement UNDER SUBSECTION
- 10 (1)(A) of 1 year of resident training if the applicant has a
- 11 baccalaureate degree from an accredited school, college, or
- 12 university, which AND the department finds to be DETERMINES THAT

- 4 REGISTERED WITH THE DEPARTMENT UNDER SECTION 6 OF THE PREPAID
- 5 FUNERAL AND CEMETERY SALES ACT, 1986 PA 255, MCL 328.216.
- 6 (B) THE APPLICANT HAS A CONTRACT WITH A REGISTRANT UNDER WHICH
- 7 THE REGISTRANT SELLS, PROVIDES, OR AGREES TO SELL OR PROVIDE
- 8 MERCHANDISE, FUNERAL SERVICES, OR CEMETERY SERVICES UNDER A PREPAID
- 9 CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT. AS USED IN THIS
- 10 SUBDIVISION AND SUBSECTION (5), "CEMETERY SERVICES", "FUNERAL
- 11 SERVICES", "MERCHANDISE", "PREPAID CONTRACT", "PROVIDER", AND
- 12 "REGISTRANT" MEAN THOSE TERMS AS DEFINED IN THE PREPAID FUNERAL AND
- 13 CEMETERY SALES ACT, 1986 PA 255, MCL 328.211 TO 328.235.
- 14 (5) IF AN ESTABLISHMENT LICENSE IS CANCELED UNDER SUBSECTION
- 15 (7) BECAUSE OF A CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP OF THE FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT,
- 16 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT GRANT A NEW LICENSE FOR THAT ESTABLISHMENT
- 17 UNLESS THE APPLICANT ASSUMES THE OBLIGATIONS OF ANY UNPERFORMED
- 18 PREPAID CONTRACTS IN WHICH THE FORMER ESTABLISHMENT WAS DESIGNATED
- 19 AS THE PROVIDER UNDER SECTION 11(1) OF THE PREPAID FUNERAL AND
- 20 CEMETERY ACT, 1986 PA 255, MCL 328.221, OR CERTIFIES THAT THE
- 21 UNPERFORMED PREPAID CONTRACTS HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED TO ANOTHER FUNERAL
- 22 ESTABLISHMENT.
- 23 (6) (3) A THE DEPARTMENT MAY INSPECT A funeral establishment
- 24 or a branch of a funeral establishment, may be inspected by the
- 25 department and shall—AND THE FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT OR BRANCH MUST
- 26 meet and conform to THE REQUIREMENTS OF section 1809 and to ANY
- 27 other lawful standards and requirements established by rule of the

- 2 revoke a license for A failure to meet those ANY OF THESE

- 5 (7) A change in the ownership or location of the funeral
- 6 establishment automatically cancels its license. A LICENSEE SHALL
- 7 IMMEDIATELY REPORT A change in ownership or location shall be
- 8 immediately reported to the department.
- 9 (8) (4) The department shall issue a mortuary science license
- 10 to an individual holding WHO HOLDS a valid license in another state
- 11 having THAT HAS substantially equal requirements to those existing
- 12 in this state who has fulfilled THE REQUIREMENTS UNDER THIS ARTICLE
- 13 IF HE OR SHE MEETS all of the following:
- 14 (a) Applied APPLIES for a license to practice in this state.
- 15 (b) Filed FILES with the department a certified statement from
- 16 the examining board of the state in which the applicant holds a
- 17 license , showing THAT SHOWS the basis upon ON which the license
- 18 was granted, and whether the license THAT BOARD has been suspended,
- 19 revoked, or limited by a state board. THAT LICENSE.
- 20 (c) Passed PASSES an examination approved by the department
- 21 and the board which THAT tests the individual's knowledge of law
- 22 relating to the practice of mortuary science in Michigan.
