SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 5363

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 17766c (MCL 333.17766c), as amended by 2011 PA 86.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 17766c. (1) A person shall not do any of the following:
- 2 (a) Purchase more than 3.6 grams of ephedrine or
- 3 pseudoephedrine alone or in a mixture within a single calendar day.
- 4 (b) Purchase more than 9 grams of ephedrine or pseudoephedrine
- 5 alone or in a mixture within a 30-day period.
- 6 (c) Possess more than 12 grams of ephedrine or pseudoephedrine
- 7 alone or in a mixture.
- 8 (D) PURCHASE OR POSSESS ANY AMOUNT OF EPHEDRINE OR
- 9 PSEUDOEPHEDRINE KNOWING OR HAVING REASON TO KNOW THAT IT IS TO BE

- 1 USED TO MANUFACTURE METHAMPHETAMINE.
- 2 (2) A person who violates this section is guilty of a crime as
- 3 follows:
- 4 (a) A person who violates subsection (1)(a) or (b) is guilty
- 5 of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 93
- 6 days or a fine of not more than \$500.00, or both.
- 7 (b) A person who violates subsection (1)(c) is guilty of a
- 8 felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 2 years or a
- 9 fine of not more than \$2,000.00, or both.
- 10 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) (D) IS GUILTY OF A
- 11 FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 5 YEARS OR A
- 12 FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.00, OR BOTH. THIS SUBDIVISION DOES NOT
- 13 PROHIBIT THE PERSON FROM BEING CHARGED WITH, CONVICTED OF, AND
- 14 SENTENCED FOR ANY OTHER VIOLATION OF LAW ARISING OUT OF THE
- 15 VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (1) (D).
- 16 (3) This section does not apply to any of the following:
- 17 (a) A person who possesses ephedrine or pseudoephedrine
- 18 pursuant to a license issued by this state or the United States to
- 19 manufacture, deliver, dispense, possess with intent to manufacture
- 20 or deliver, or possess a controlled substance, prescription drug,
- 21 or other drug.
- (b) An individual who possesses ephedrine or pseudoephedrine
- 23 pursuant to a prescription.
- 24 (c) A person who possesses ephedrine or pseudoephedrine for
- 25 retail sale pursuant to a license issued under the general sales
- 26 tax act, 1933 PA 167, MCL 205.51 to 205.78.
- 27 (d) A person who possesses ephedrine or pseudoephedrine in the

- 1 course of his or her business of selling or transporting ephedrine
- 2 or pseudoephedrine to a person described in subdivision (a) or (c).
- 3 (e) A person who, in the course of his or her business, stores
- 4 ephedrine or pseudoephedrine for sale or distribution to a person
- 5 described in subdivision (a), (c), or (d).
- 6 (f) Any product that the state board of pharmacy, upon
- 7 application of a manufacturer, exempts from this section because
- 8 the product has been formulated in such a way as to effectively
- 9 prevent the conversion of the active ingredient into
- 10 methamphetamine.
- 11 (g) Possession of any pediatric product primarily intended for
- 12 administration to children under 12 years of age according to label
- 13 instructions.
- 14 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect January
