## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 2 MEDICAL GOOD-FAITH PROVISIONS
- 3 SEC. 20401. THIS PART SHALL BE KNOWN AND MAY BE CITED AS THE
- 4 "MEDICAL GOOD-FAITH PROVISIONS ACT".
- 5 SEC. 20403. (1) UPON THE REQUEST OF A PATIENT OR RESIDENT OR A
- 6 PROSPECTIVE PATIENT OR RESIDENT, A HEALTH FACILITY OR AGENCY SHALL
- 7 DISCLOSE IN WRITING ANY POLICIES RELATED TO A PATIENT OR RESIDENT
- 8 OR THE SERVICES A PATIENT OR RESIDENT MAY RECEIVE INVOLVING LIFE-
- 9 SUSTAINING OR NONBENEFICIAL TREATMENT WITHIN THAT HEALTH FACILITY
- 10 OR AGENCY.

## Senate Bill No. 165 (H-2) as amended May 21, 2013

- 1 (2) IF THE PATIENT OR RESIDENT OR PROSPECTIVE PATIENT OR
- 2 RESIDENT IS A MINOR [OR WARD], THE HEALTH FACILITY OR AGENCY SHALL [UPON REQUEST] PROVIDE IN
- 3 WRITING THE POLICIES DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) TO A PARENT OR
- 4 LEGAL GUARDIAN OF THE PATIENT OR RESIDENT OR PROSPECTIVE PATIENT OR
- 5 RESIDENT.
- 6 SEC. 20405. THIS PART DOES NOT REQUIRE A HEALTH FACILITY OR
- 7 AGENCY TO ESTABLISH OR MAINTAIN A POLICY DESCRIBED IN SECTION 20403
- 8 THAT IS NOT ALREADY REQUIRED BY FEDERAL OR STATE LAW ON THE
- 9 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS PART.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 11 after it is enacted into law.
