SENATE BILL NO. 352

A bill to amend 1893 PA 206, entitled "The general property tax act," by amending section 7b (MCL 211.7b).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7b. (1) Real estate PROPERTY used and owned as a
- 2 homestead by a soldier or sailor DISABLED VETERAN who was
- 3 discharged FROM THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES under
- 4 honorable conditions with a service connected disability, and who
- 5 has a certificate from the United States veterans' administration,
- 6 or its successors, certifying the soldier or sailor is receiving or
- 7 has received pecuniary assistance due to disability for specially
- 8 adapted housing, shall be OR BY AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN
- 9 SUBSECTION (2) IS exempt from taxation. THE COLLECTION OF TAXES
- 10 UNDER THIS ACT. To obtain the exemption, an affidavit , accompanied

- 1 by the certificate, showing the facts required by this section and
- 2 a description of the REAL property shall be filed BY THE PROPERTY
- 3 OWNER OR HIS OR HER LEGAL DESIGNEE with the supervisor or other
- 4 assessing officer . The affidavit and accompanying certificate
- 5 shall be filed during the period beginning with the tax day for
- 6 each year and ending at the time of the final adjournment of the
- 7 local board of review. The affidavit and accompanying certificate
- 8 when filed shall be open to inspection. The county treasurer is
- 9 hereby authorized, pursuant to section 55, to SHALL cancel the
- 10 taxes SUBJECT TO COLLECTION UNDER THIS ACT for any year in which a
- 11 soldier or sailor DISABLED VETERAN ELIGIBLE FOR THE EXEMPTION UNDER
- 12 THIS SECTION has acquired title to real estate—PROPERTY exempt
- 13 under this section. Upon the granting of the exemption as allowed
- 14 in-UNDER this section, each local taxing unit shall bear the loss
- 15 of their ITS portion of the taxes upon which the exemption has been
- 16 claimed and allowed. GRANTED.
- 17 (2) If a soldier or sailor entitled to DISABLED VETERAN WHO IS
- 18 OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE FOR the exemption permitted by UNDER this
- 19 section dies, EITHER BEFORE OR AFTER THE EXEMPTION UNDER THIS
- 20 SECTION IS GRANTED, the exemption shall REMAIN AVAILABLE TO OR
- 21 SHALL continue in favor of the FOR HIS OR HER unremarried surviving
- 22 spouse. of the soldier or sailor. The SURVIVING spouse shall comply
- 23 with the requirements of subsection (1) and shall indicate on the
- 24 affidavit that he or she is the surviving spouse of a soldier or
- 25 sailor DISABLED VETERAN entitled to THE exemption by UNDER this
- 26 section. The exemption shall continue as long as the surviving
- 27 spouse remains unremarried.

- 1 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "DISABLED VETERAN" MEANS A PERSON
- 2 WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE AND WHO MEETS 1 OF THE FOLLOWING
- 3 CRITERIA:
- 4 (A) HAS BEEN DETERMINED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF
- 5 VETERANS AFFAIRS TO BE PERMANENTLY AND TOTALLY DISABLED AS A RESULT
- 6 OF MILITARY SERVICE AND ENTITLED TO VETERANS' BENEFITS AT THE 100%
- 7 RATE.
- 8 (B) HAS A CERTIFICATE FROM THE UNITED STATES VETERANS!
- 9 ADMINISTRATION, OR ITS SUCCESSORS, CERTIFYING THAT HE OR SHE IS
- 10 RECEIVING OR HAS RECEIVED PECUNIARY ASSISTANCE DUE TO DISABILITY
- 11 FOR SPECIALLY ADAPTED HOUSING.
 - [(C) HAS BEEN RATED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS AS INDIVIDUALLY UNEMPLOYABLE.]
