 - (2) BEGINNING ON THE EARLIER OF THE FOLLOWING DATES, THE TWENTY-NINTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT HAS 1 JUDGE:
 - (A) THE DATE ON WHICH A VACANCY OCCURS IN THE OFFICE OF CIRCUIT JUDGE IN THE TWENTY-NINTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT.
