SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 663

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961,"

(MCL 600.101 to 600.9947) by adding section 2949b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 2949B. (1) THE MANUFACTURER OF A VEHICLE IS NOT LIABLE
- 2 FOR DAMAGES RESULTING FROM ANY OF THE FOLLOWING UNLESS THE DEFECT
- 3 FROM WHICH THE DAMAGES RESULTED WAS PRESENT IN THE VEHICLE WHEN IT
- 4 WAS MANUFACTURED:
- 5 (A) THE CONVERSION OR ATTEMPTED CONVERSION OF THE VEHICLE INTO
- 6 AN AUTOMATED MOTOR VEHICLE BY ANOTHER PERSON.
- 7 (B) THE INSTALLATION OF EQUIPMENT IN THE VEHICLE BY ANOTHER
- 8 PERSON TO CONVERT IT INTO AN AUTOMATED MOTOR VEHICLE.
- 9 (C) THE MODIFICATION BY ANOTHER PERSON OF EQUIPMENT THAT WAS

- 1 INSTALLED BY THE MANUFACTURER IN AN AUTOMATED MOTOR VEHICLE
- 2 SPECIFICALLY FOR USING THE VEHICLE IN AUTOMATIC MODE.
- 3 (2) A SUBCOMPONENT SYSTEM PRODUCER RECOGNIZED AS DESCRIBED IN
- 4 SECTION 244 OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.244,
- 5 IS NOT LIABLE IN A PRODUCT LIABILITY ACTION FOR DAMAGES RESULTING
- 6 FROM THE MODIFICATION OF EQUIPMENT INSTALLED BY THE SUBCOMPONENT
- 7 SYSTEM PRODUCER TO CONVERT A VEHICLE TO AN AUTOMATED MOTOR VEHICLE
- 8 UNLESS THE DEFECT FROM WHICH THE DAMAGES RESULTED WAS PRESENT IN
- 9 THE EQUIPMENT WHEN IT WAS INSTALLED BY THE SUBCOMPONENT SYSTEM
- 10 PRODUCER.
- 11 (3) SECTIONS 2945 TO 2949A DO NOT APPLY IN A PRODUCT LIABILITY
- 12 ACTION TO THE EXTENT THAT THEY ARE INCONSISTENT WITH THIS SECTION.
- 13 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 14 (A) "AUTOMATED MOTOR VEHICLE" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN
- 15 SECTION 2B OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.2B.
- 16 (B) "AUTOMATIC MODE" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2B
- 17 OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.2B.
- 18 (C) "VEHICLE" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 79 OF THE
- 19 MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.79.
- 20 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 21 unless Senate Bill No. 169 of the 97th Legislature is enacted into
- 22 law.
