THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 42501. (1) A person shall not engage in the business of
- 2 buying, selling, dealing, or the tanning and dressing of raw furs,
- 3 hides, or pelts of beaver, otter, fisher, marten, muskrat, mink,
- skunk, raccoon, opossum, wolf, lynx, bobcat, fox, weasel, coyote,
- badger, deer, or bear and the plumage, skins, or hides of protected
- 6 game birds or game animals except as authorized by a license issued
- 7 by the department pursuant to UNDER part 13. A license application
- 8 shall be accompanied by a fee as follows:

- 1 (a) For any person who engages in the business of buying and
- 2 selling raw furs, hides, and pelts of fur-bearing animals or the
- 3 plumage, skins, or hides of protected game birds or game animals,
- 4 the fee is \$10.00.
- 5 (b) Each person in the business of manufacturing furs who buys
- 6 raw pelts is a dealer, and the fee for each individual or agent who
- 7 buys furs is, for a resident, \$10.00 and, for a nonresident,
- **8** \$50.00.
- 9 (c) For any person who engages in the business of custom
- 10 tanning or dressing of raw furs, the fee is \$5.00. However, such a
- 11 license does not authorize that person to buy or sell raw furs.
- 12 (2) Any person holding a fur dealer's license under this part
- 13 is entitled to buy furs, hides, pelts, and the plumage, skins, or
- 14 hides, and parts thereof, of protected game birds and game animals
- 15 that are legally taken.
- 16 (3) A person holding a fur dealer's license under this part is
- 17 not eligible to secure or hold a license to trap beaver.
- 18 (3) (4)—The department may designate the plumage and skin of
- 19 those game birds and game animals that may not be bought or sold if
- 20 it determines that such a prohibition will best serve the public
- 21 interest. The plumage and skins, or parts of plumage and skins, of
- 22 migratory game and nongame birds may be bought and sold only in
- 23 accordance with federal law or rule.
- 24 (4) (5) For the purposes of this part, "plumage" means any
- 25 part of the feathers, head, wings, or tail of any bird.
