

# HOUSE BILL No. 4012

January 22, 2013, Introduced by Rep. Heise and referred to the Committee on Elections and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled  
"Michigan election law,"  
(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 558a.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           SEC. 558A. IF A CANDIDATE FILES NOMINATING PETITIONS FOR A  
2 FEDERAL, STATE, COUNTY, CITY, TOWNSHIP, VILLAGE, OR SCHOOL DISTRICT  
3 OFFICE, THE CANDIDATE SHALL FILE WITH THE OFFICER WITH WHOM THE  
4 NOMINATING PETITIONS ARE FILED A SIGNED AFFIDAVIT ATTESTING TO THE  
5 FACT THAT THE CANDIDATE HAS REVIEWED THE SIGNATURES ON THE  
6 NOMINATING PETITIONS AND THAT TO THE BEST OF HIS OR HER KNOWLEDGE  
7 THE SIGNATURES ON THE NOMINATING PETITIONS WERE COLLECTED IN  
8 ACCORDANCE WITH STATE LAW AND ARE VALID.
