HOUSE BILL No. 4036

January 22, 2013, Introduced by Rep. Geiss and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 224 (MCL 257.224), as amended by 2006 PA 177.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 224. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this act regarding tabs or stickers, upon registering a vehicle, the secretary of state shall issue to the owner 1 registration plate.

(2) A registration plate shall display the registration number assigned to the vehicle for which the registration plate is issued; the name of this state, which may be abbreviated; and when the registration plate expires, which may be shown by a tab or sticker furnished by the secretary of state. A REGISTRATION PLATE OR SCHEME SHALL EXCLUSIVELY DISPLAY, DISSEMINATE, OR CONVEY INFORMATION IN A

- 1 VISUAL MANNER, AND SHALL NOT INDICATE THE AGE OR RELATIVE AGE OF A
- 2 REGISTERED OWNER OR VEHICLE OPERATOR THROUGH THE USE OF COLOR,
- 3 NUMBER, LETTER, SYMBOL, OR OTHER METHOD.
- 4 (3) A registration plate issued for motor vehicles owned and
- 5 operated by this state; a state institution; a municipality; a
- 6 privately incorporated, nonprofit volunteer fire department; or a
- 7 nonpublic, nonprofit college or university of this state shall DOES
- 8 not expire at any particular time but shall be renewed when the
- 9 registration plate is worn out or is-illegible. This registration
- 10 plate shall be assigned upon proper application and payment of the
- 11 applicable fee and may be used on any eligible vehicle titled to
- 12 the applicant if a written record is kept of the vehicles upon
- which the registration plate is used. The written record shall
- 14 state the time the registration plate is used on a particular
- 15 vehicle. The record shall be open to inspection by a law
- 16 enforcement officer or a representative of the secretary of state.
- 17 (4) A registration plate issued for a vehicle owned by the
- 18 civil air patrol as organized under 36 USC 201 to 208; 40301 TO
- 19 40307; a vehicle owned by a nonprofit organization and used to
- 20 transport equipment for providing dialysis treatment to children at
- 21 camp; an emergency support vehicle used exclusively for emergencies
- 22 and owned and operated by a federally recognized nonprofit
- 23 charitable organization; a vehicle owned and operated by a
- 24 nonprofit veterans center; a motor vehicle having a truck chassis
- 25 and a locomotive or ship's body which THAT is owned by a nonprofit
- 26 veterans organization and used exclusively in parades and civic
- 27 events; a vehicle owned and operated by a nonprofit recycling

- 1 center or a federally recognized nonprofit conservation
- 2 organization until December 31, 2000; a motor vehicle owned and
- 3 operated by a senior citizen center; and a registration plate
- 4 issued for buses including station wagons, carryalls, or similarly
- 5 constructed vehicles owned and operated by a nonprofit parents'
- 6 transportation corporation used for school purposes, parochial
- 7 school, society, church Sunday school, or other grammar school, or
- 8 by a nonprofit youth organization or nonprofit rehabilitation
- 9 facility shall be issued upon proper application and payment of the
- 10 applicable tax provided in section 801(1)(g) or (h) to the
- 11 applicant for the vehicle identified in the application. The
- 12 vehicle shall be used exclusively for activities of the school or
- 13 organization and shall be designated by proper signs showing the
- 14 school or organization operating the vehicle. The registration
- 15 plate shall expire on December 31 in the fifth year following the
- 16 date of issuance. The registration plate may be transferred to
- another vehicle upon proper application and payment of a \$10.00
- 18 transfer fee.
- 19 (5) Beginning January 1, 2007, the THE department shall not
- 20 issue or transfer a standard design beads on paint registration
- 21 plate or issue a registration tab or sticker for that plate, but
- 22 shall offer a new standard design registration plate that complies
- 23 with the requirements of this act, . The new standard design
- 24 registration plate shall be IS of a common color scheme and design,
- 25 that AND is made of fully reflectorized material and shall be THAT
- 26 IS clearly visible at night. The implementation of this subsection
- 27 is contingent upon appropriations sufficient to cover the costs to

- 1 the department of designing, manufacturing, distributing, and
- 2 issuing the new standard design registration plate. The secretary
- 3 of state shall file a written report with the secretary of the
- 4 senate and the clerk of the house of representatives of the costs
- 5 incurred and revenue expended to meet the requirements of this
- 6 subsection within 30 days after all of the standard design beads on
- 7 paint registration plates to be replaced under this subsection have
- 8 been replaced.
- 9 (6) The registration plate and the required letters and
- 10 numerals on the registration plate shall be of sufficient size to
- 11 be plainly readable from a distance of 100 feet during daylight.
- 12 The secretary of state may issue a tab or tabs designating the
- 13 month and year of expiration.
- 14 (7) The secretary of state shall issue for every passenger
- 15 motor vehicle rented without a driver the same type of registration
- 16 plate as the type of registration plate issued for private
- 17 passenger vehicles.
- 18 (8) A person shall not operate a vehicle on the public
- 19 highways or streets of this state displaying a registration plate
- 20 other than the registration plate issued for the vehicle by the
- 21 secretary of state, except as provided in this chapter for
- 22 nonresidents, and by assignment provided in subsection (3).
- 23 (9) The registration plate displayed on a vehicle registered
- 24 on the basis of elected gross weight shall indicate the elected
- 25 gross weight for which the vehicle is registered.
- 26 (10) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2013, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT RENEW
- 27 AN AUTO CENTENNIAL REGISTRATION PLATE.

- 1 (11) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, BEGINNING
- 2 JUNE 1, 2013, A REGISTRATION PLATE NEWLY OR PREVIOUSLY ISSUED BY
- 3 THE DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL NOT BE RENEWED AFTER A
- 4 PERIOD OF 12 YEARS FROM THE DATE OF THE PLATE'S ISSUANCE. THE OWNER
- 5 OF A VEHICLE WHOSE REGISTRATION PLATE IS PROHIBITED FROM BEING
- 6 RENEWED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL PAY THE SAME FEE FOR A NEW
- 7 REGISTRATION PLATE AS THE FEE REQUIRED FOR A DUPLICATE OR
- 8 REPLACEMENT STANDARD OR GRAPHIC STANDARD PLATE UNDER SECTION 804.
- 9 ON OCTOBER 1, 2013 AND ANNUALLY THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 10 PROVIDE A REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE THAT CONTAINS ALL OF THE
- 11 FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 12 (A) AN ITEMIZATION OF ALL EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE DEPARTMENT
- 13 IN COMPLYING WITH THIS SUBSECTION.
- 14 (B) THE NUMBER OF REGISTRATION PLATES REQUIRED TO BE REPLACED
- 15 UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.
- 16 (C) THE COST OF PROGRAMMING AND PRODUCTION.
- 17 (D) WHETHER ANY MANUFACTURED REGISTRATION PLATE LOTS OR SERIES
- 18 CONTAINED REGISTRATION PLATES THAT VIOLATED ANY PROMULGATED
- 19 STANDARDS OR VENDOR WARRANTIES, OR WERE SUBSEQUENTLY FOUND TO BE
- 20 RELATIVELY SUBSTANDARD BY THE DEPARTMENT, ADMINISTRATION DESIGNEE,
- 21 OR CONTRACTUAL AGENT.
