A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1242.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1242. (1) NOT LATER THAN JANUARY 1, 2014, THE BOARD OF A
- 2 SCHOOL DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF
- 3 DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT A
- POLICY CONCERNING THE USE OF PUBLIC RESOURCES FOR POLITICAL
- 5 ACTIVITIES. AT A MINIMUM, THE POLICY SHALL PROHIBIT EMPLOYEES,
- 6 BOARD MEMBERS, AND VOLUNTEERS FROM DOING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (A) ENGAGING IN ANY LOBBYING DURING SCHOOL HOURS OR OTHER PAID
- 8 WORK TIME.
  - (B) EXPENDING PUBLIC FUNDS OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT,
