A bill to limit the compensation for positions in the executive branch of state government that are not a part of the classified service.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. (1) This act shall be known and may be cited as the appointed position compensation limitation act".
- (2) Any officer or employee who holds an appointed position in the executive branch of state government that is not a part of the classified service shall not receive compensation for that position that is more than the amount recommended by the civil service commission pursuant to section 5 of article XI of the state constitution of 1963.
