## **HOUSE BILL No. 4435**

March 12, 2013, Introduced by Reps. Brinks, Ananich, LaVoy, Faris, Singh, Smiley, Knezek, Rutledge, Brunner, Brown, Greimel, Barnett, Hovey-Wright, Roberts, McCann, Banks, Townsend, Dillon, Switalski, Yanez, Kosowski, Hobbs, Driskell, Kandrevas, Tlaib, Lamonte, Cavanagh, Schor, Slavens, Lipton and Abed and referred to the Committee on Elections and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending section 558 (MCL 168.558), as amended by 2012 PA 586.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 558. (1) When filing a nominating petition, qualifying

petition, filing fee, or affidavit of candidacy for a federal, county, state, city, township, village, metropolitan district, or school district office in any election, a candidate shall file with the officer with whom the petitions, fee, or affidavit is filed 2 copies of an affidavit of identity. A candidate nominated for a federal, state, county, city, township, or village office at a political party convention or caucus shall file WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE an affidavit of identity within 1 business day after being nominated. with the secretary of state. The affidavit of identity

- 4 CANDIDATE SHALL FILE A NOMINATING PETITION, QUALIFYING PETITION,
- 5 FILING FEE, AFFIDAVIT OF CANDIDACY, OR AFFIDAVIT OF IDENTITY IN
- 6 PERSON WITH THE OFFICER WITH WHOM THE PETITIONS, FEE, OR AFFIDAVITS
- 7 ARE FILED AND SHALL IDENTIFY HIMSELF OR HERSELF TO THE OFFICER WITH
- 8 WHOM THE PETITIONS, FEE, OR AFFIDAVITS ARE FILED BY PRESENTING AN
- 9 OFFICIAL STATE IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED TO THAT INDIVIDUAL UNDER
- 10 1972 PA 222, MCL 28.291 TO 28.300, AN OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S
- 11 LICENSE ISSUED TO THAT INDIVIDUAL UNDER THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE,
- 12 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 TO 257.923, OR OTHER GENERALLY RECOGNIZED
- 13 PICTURE IDENTIFICATION CARD. THE REQUIREMENT TO FILE A NOMINATING
- 14 PETITION, QUALIFYING PETITION, FILING FEE, AFFIDAVIT OF CANDIDACY,
- 15 OR AFFIDAVIT OF IDENTITY IN PERSON WITH THE OFFICER WITH WHOM THE
- 16 PETITIONS, FEE, OR AFFIDAVITS ARE FILED, ALONG WITH THE REQUIREMENT
- 17 OF PRESENTING AN AUTHORIZED PICTURE IDENTIFICATION CARD, DOES NOT
- 18 APPLY TO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING CANDIDATES:
- 19 (A) A CANDIDATE FOR FEDERAL OFFICE.
- 20 (B) A CANDIDATE FOR THE OFFICE OF JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME
- 21 COURT.
- 22 (C) A CANDIDATE FOR THE OFFICE OF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF
- 23 APPEALS.
- 24 (2) An affidavit of identity shall contain the candidate's
- 25 name, address, and ward and precinct where registered, if qualified
- 26 to vote at that election; a statement that the candidate is a
- 27 citizen of the United States; the candidate's number of years of

- 1 residence in the state and county; other information that may be
- 2 required to satisfy the officer as to the identity of the
- 3 candidate; the manner in which the candidate wishes to have his or
- 4 her name appear on the ballot; and a statement that the candidate
- 5 either is or is not using a name, whether a given name, a surname,
- 6 or otherwise, that is not a name that he or she was given at birth.
- 7 If a candidate is using a name that is not a name that he or she
- 8 was given at birth, the candidate shall include on the affidavit of
- 9 identity the candidate's full former name.
- 10 (3) The requirement to indicate a name change on the affidavit
- 11 of identity does not apply if the name in question is 1 of the
- 12 following:
- 13 (a) A name that was formally changed at least 10 years before
- 14 filing as a candidate.
- 15 (b) A name that was changed in a certificate of naturalization
- 16 issued by a federal district court at the time the individual
- 17 became a naturalized citizen at least 10 years before filing as a
- 18 candidate.
- 19 (c) A name that was changed because of marriage.
- 20 (d) A name that was changed because of divorce, but only if to
- 21 a legal name by which the individual was previously known.
- 22 (4) An affidavit of identity shall include a statement that as
- 23 of the date of the affidavit, all statements, reports, late filing
- 24 fees, and fines required of the candidate or any candidate
- 25 committee organized to support the candidate's election under the
- 26 Michigan campaign finance act, 1976 PA 388, MCL 169.201 to 169.282,
- 27 have been filed or paid; and a statement that the candidate

- 1 acknowledges that making a false statement in the affidavit is
- 2 perjury, punishable by a fine up to \$1,000.00 or imprisonment for
- 3 up to 5 years, or both. If a candidate files the affidavit of
- 4 identity with an officer other than the county clerk or secretary
- 5 of state, the officer shall immediately forward to the county clerk
- 6 1 copy of the affidavit of identity by first-class mail. The county
- 7 clerk shall immediately forward 1 copy of the affidavit of identity
- 8 for state and federal candidates to the secretary of state by
- 9 first-class mail. An officer shall not certify to the board of
- 10 election commissioners the name of a candidate who fails to comply
- 11 with this section.
- 12 (5) If petitions or filing fees are filed by or in behalf of a
- 13 candidate FILES PETITIONS OR FILING FEES for more than 1 office,
- 14 either federal, state, county, city, village, township,
- 15 metropolitan district, or school district, the terms of which run
- 16 concurrently or overlap, the candidate so filing, or in behalf of
- 17 whom petitions or fees were so filed, shall select the 1 office to
- 18 which his or her candidacy is restricted within 3 days after the
- 19 last day for the filing of petitions or filing fees unless the
- 20 petitions or filing fees are filed for 2 offices that are combined
- 21 or for offices that are not incompatible. Failure to make the
- 22 selection disqualifies a candidate with respect to each office for
- 23 which petitions or fees were so filed and the name of the candidate
- 24 shall not be printed upon the ballot for those offices. A vote cast
- 25 for that candidate at the ensuing primary or general election shall
- 26 not be counted and is void.
