## **HOUSE BILL No. 4500**

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2959. (1) In an action based on tort or another legal
- 2 theory seeking damages for personal injury, property damage, or
- 3 wrongful death, the court shall reduce the damages by the
- 4 percentage of comparative fault of the person upon whose injury or
- 5 death the damages are based as provided in section 6306 or 6306a,
- 6 as applicable. If that person's percentage of fault is greater than
- 7 the aggregate fault of the other person or persons, whether or not
- 8 parties to the action, the court shall reduce economic damages by
- 9 the percentage of comparative fault of the person upon whose injury

- 1 or death the damages are based as provided in section 6306 or
- 2 6306a, as applicable, and noneconomic damages shall not be awarded.
- 3 (2) IN AN ACTION DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1), WHETHER A
- 4 CONDITION IS OPEN AND OBVIOUS MAY BE CONSIDERED BY THE TRIER OF
- 5 FACT ONLY IN ASSESSING THE DEGREE OF COMPARATIVE FAULT, IF ANY, AND
