A bill to amend 1947 PA 336, entitled

"An act to prohibit strikes by certain public employees; to provide review from disciplinary action with respect thereto; to provide for the mediation of grievances and the holding of elections; to declare and protect the rights and privileges of public employees; to require certain provisions in collective bargaining agreements; to prescribe means of enforcement and penalties for the violation of the provisions of this act; and to make appropriations,"

(MCL 423.201 to 423.217) by adding section 15a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 15A. AN EMPLOYEE OF A PUBLIC FIRE DEPARTMENT MAY
- 2 VOLUNTEER FOR OR SEEK AND ACCEPT PART-TIME OR PAID ON-CALL
- 3 EMPLOYMENT WITH ANOTHER FIRE DEPARTMENT IF THAT EMPLOYMENT DOES NOT
- CONFLICT WITH HIS OR HER PERFORMANCE OF THE ORIGINAL EMPLOYMENT.
- 5 COLLECTIVE BARGAINING BETWEEN A PUBLIC EMPLOYER AND A BARGAINING
- 6 REPRESENTATIVE OF ITS EMPLOYEES SHALL NOT INCLUDE THE SUBJECT OF A
- 7 PROHIBITION ON AN EMPLOYEE VOLUNTEERING FOR OR OBTAINING EMPLOYMENT
 - WITH ANOTHER FIRE DEPARTMENT.
