HOUSE BILL No. 4633

April 25, 2013, Introduced by Rep. Schmidt and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 224 (MCL 257.224), as amended by 2012 PA 491.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 224. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this act
 regarding tabs or stickers, upon registering a vehicle, the
 secretary of state shall issue to the owner 1 registration plate.
 - (2) A registration plate shall display the registration number assigned to the vehicle for which the registration plate is issued; the name of this state, which may be abbreviated; and when the registration plate expires, which may be shown by a tab or sticker furnished by the secretary of state.
 - (3) A registration plate issued for motor vehicles owned and operated by this state; a state institution; a municipality; a

- 1 privately incorporated, nonprofit volunteer fire department; or a
- 2 nonpublic, nonprofit college or university of this state shall not
- 3 expire at any particular time but shall be renewed when the
- 4 registration plate is worn out or is illegible. This registration
- 5 plate shall be assigned upon proper application and payment of the
- 6 applicable fee and may be used on any eligible vehicle titled to
- 7 the applicant if a written record is kept of the vehicles upon
- 8 which the registration plate is used. The written record shall
- 9 state the time the registration plate is used on a particular
- 10 vehicle. The record shall be open to inspection by a law
- 11 enforcement officer or a representative of the secretary of state.
- 12 (4) A registration plate issued for a vehicle owned by the
- 13 civil air patrol as organized under 36 USC 201 to 208; 40301 TO
- 14 40307; a vehicle owned by a nonprofit organization and used to
- 15 transport equipment for providing dialysis treatment to children at
- 16 camp; an emergency support vehicle used exclusively for emergencies
- 17 and owned and operated by a federally recognized nonprofit
- 18 charitable organization; a vehicle owned and operated by a
- 19 nonprofit veterans center; a motor vehicle having a truck chassis
- 20 and a locomotive or ship's body which is owned by a nonprofit
- 21 veterans organization and used exclusively in parades and civic
- 22 events; a vehicle owned and operated by a nonprofit recycling
- 23 center or a federally recognized nonprofit conservation
- 24 organization until December 31, 2000; a motor vehicle owned and
- 25 operated by a senior citizen center; and a registration plate
- 26 issued for buses including station wagons, carryalls, or similarly
- 27 constructed vehicles owned and operated by a nonprofit parents'

- 1 transportation corporation used for school purposes, parochial
- 2 school, society, church Sunday school, or other grammar school, or
- 3 by a nonprofit youth organization or nonprofit rehabilitation
- 4 facility shall be issued upon proper application and payment of the
- 5 applicable tax provided in section 801(1)(g) or (h) to the
- 6 applicant for the vehicle identified in the application. The
- 7 vehicle shall be used exclusively for activities of the school or
- 8 organization and shall be designated by proper signs showing the
- 9 school or organization operating the vehicle. The registration
- 10 plate shall expire EXPIRES on December 31 in the fifth year
- 11 following the date of issuance. The registration plate may be
- 12 transferred to another vehicle upon proper application and payment
- of a \$10.00 transfer fee.
- 14 (5) The department shall not issue or transfer a standard
- 15 design beads on paint registration plate or issue a registration
- 16 tab or sticker for that plate, but shall offer a new standard
- 17 design registration plate that complies with the requirements of
- 18 this act. The new standard design registration plate shall be of a
- 19 common color scheme and design that is made of fully reflectorized
- 20 material and shall be clearly visible at night. The implementation
- 21 of this subsection is contingent upon appropriations sufficient to
- 22 cover the costs to the department of designing, manufacturing,
- 23 distributing, and issuing the new standard design registration
- 24 plate. The secretary of state shall file a written report with the
- 25 secretary of the senate and the clerk of the house of
- 26 representatives of the costs incurred and revenue expended to meet
- 27 the requirements of this subsection within 30 days after all of the

- 1 standard design beads on paint registration plates to be replaced
- 2 under this subsection have been replaced. NO LATER THAN JANUARY 1,
- 3 2015, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL USE A DIGITAL PRINTING METHOD TO CREATE
- 4 ALL STANDARD DESIGN REGISTRATION PLATES. AS USED IN THIS
- 5 SUBSECTION, "DIGITAL PRINTING METHOD" MEANS A METHOD OF CREATING A
- 6 REGISTRATION PLATE USING A RETROFLECTIVE SHEETING MATERIAL THAT IS
- 7 PRINTED DIGITALLY USING THERMAL TRANSFER RIBBONS AND THEN LAMINATED
- 8 TO AN ALUMINUM SUBSTRATE.
- 9 (6) The department may use the Pure Michigan brand or a
- 10 successor or similar brand that is used in conjunction with the
- 11 state's promotion, travel, and tourism campaigns or marketing
- 12 efforts as part of the standard design for registration plates.
- 13 (7) The registration plate and the required letters and
- 14 numerals on the registration plate shall be of sufficient size to
- 15 be plainly readable from a distance of 100 feet during daylight.
- 16 The secretary of state may issue a tab or tabs designating the
- 17 month and year of expiration.
- 18 (8) The secretary of state shall issue for every passenger
- 19 motor vehicle rented without a driver the same type of registration
- 20 plate as the type of registration plate issued for private
- 21 passenger vehicles.
- 22 (9) A person shall not operate a vehicle on the public
- 23 highways or streets of this state displaying a registration plate
- 24 other than the registration plate issued for the vehicle by the
- 25 secretary of state, except as provided in this chapter for
- 26 nonresidents, and OR by assignment AS provided in subsection (3).
- 27 (10) The registration plate displayed on a vehicle registered

- 1 on the basis of elected gross weight shall indicate the elected
- 2 gross weight for which the vehicle is registered.
- 3 (11) BEGINNING ON JANUARY 1, 2015, A REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED
- 4 BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS SECTION EXPIRES 8 YEARS AFTER THE DATE
- 5 THAT REGISTRATION PLATE WAS ISSUED. THE OWNER OF A VEHICLE WHOSE
- 6 REGISTRATION PLATE EXPIRES UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL OBTAIN A
- 7 REPLACEMENT REGISTRATION PLATE UPON PAYMENT OF THE FEE REQUIRED
- 8 UNDER SECTION 804. UPON REQUEST OF THE OWNER OF A VEHICLE WHOSE
- 9 REGISTRATION PLATE HAS EXPIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE
- 10 DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A NEW REGISTRATION PLATE WITH THE SAME
- 11 REGISTRATION NUMBER AS WAS DISPLAYED ON THE EXPIRED REGISTRATION
- 12 PLATE UPON PAYMENT OF A \$10.00 FEE.
