## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 18. (1) If an election for board members or a
- 2 districtwide tax is to be held in conjunction with a general
- 3 election or a state primary election immediately preceding BEFORE a
- 4 general election and none of the participating municipalities are
- 5 school districts, the notices of close of registration and election
  - shall be published as provided for by the state election laws.
- 7 Otherwise, if none of the participating municipalities are school
- 8 districts, the county clerk of the largest county shall publish the
- notices of close of registration and election. The notice of close
