## **HOUSE BILL No. 4744**

May 16, 2013, Introduced by Reps. Haugh, Schor, Tlaib, Faris, Roberts, Dillon, Goike, Yonker, Geiss, Foster, Crawford, McBroom, Lane, McCann, Driskell, Dianda and Nathan and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 2011 PA 256, entitled "Michigan fireworks safety act," by amending sections 10 and 11 (MCL 28.460 and 28.461).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 10. A retailer shall remit the fireworks safety fee as described in section 9 to the department on forms and in the manner prescribed by the department, shall hold the fireworks safety fees collected in trust for the state until remitted to the state, and is personally liable for the payment of the fireworks safety fee money to this state.

(1) THE RETAILER OR PERSON TO WHOM A CONSUMER FIREWORKS
CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED IS RESPONSIBLE FOR REMITTING ALL FIREWORKS
SAFETY FEES AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 9 TO THE DEPARTMENT ON FORMS
AND IN THE MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT; SHALL HOLD THE

- 1 FIREWORKS SAFETY FEES COLLECTED IN TRUST FOR THE STATE UNTIL

- Sec. 11. (1) The fireworks safety fund is created within the

- 14 (2) The state treasurer may receive money or other assets from
- 15 any source for deposit into the fund. The state treasurer shall
- 16 direct the investment of the fund. The state treasurer shall credit
- 17 to the fund interest and earnings from fund investments.

- 7 (B) ONE HUNDRED PERCENT OF THE MONEY RECEIVED FROM CONSUMER
- 8 FIREWORKS SAFETY CERTIFICATES UNDER SECTION 4 TO ADMINISTER THIS
- 9 ACT AND TO PAY THE COSTS OF DELEGATING INSPECTIONS UNDER THIS ACT
- 10 TO LOCAL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (5).
- 11 (5) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ESTABLISH A PROGRAM FOR DELEGATING
- 12 INSPECTION DUTIES UNDER THIS ACT TO 1 OR MORE LOCAL UNITS OF
- 13 GOVERNMENT. IF A LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT AGREES TO CARRY OUT
- 14 INSPECTIONS, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PAY 70% OF THE CONSUMER FIREWORKS
- 15 SAFETY CERTIFICATE FEE PAID BY EACH RETAIL LOCATION INSPECTED BY
- 16 THE LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT AND RETAIN THE REMAINING 30% OF THAT
- 17 FEE. IF A LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT DECLINES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE
- 18 PROGRAM DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION, THE DEPARTMENT RETAINS ITS
- 19 INSPECTION DUTIES UNDER THIS ACT.
