HOUSE BILL No. 4866

June 20, 2013, Introduced by Reps. Forlini, Rendon, Driskell, Dianda, Cochran, Howrylak, Schor, Rutledge, Jacobsen, Switalski, Pettalia, Kowall and Lane and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," by amending section 648 (MCL 257.648).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 648. (1) The driver OPERATOR of a vehicle or bicycle upon a highway, before stopping or turning from a direct line, shall first see DETERMINE that the stopping or turning can be made in safety and shall give a signal as required in this section.
 - (2) A—EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (5), A signal required in—UNDER this section shall be given either by means of the hand and arm in the manner specified in this section, or by a mechanical or electrical signal device which—THAT conveys an intelligible signal or warning to other highway traffic. , except as otherwise provided in subsection (3).

- 1 (3) When a PERSON IS OPERATING A VEHICLE AND signal is given
- 2 by means of the hand and arm, the driver OPERATOR shall indicate
