

HOUSE BILL No. 4898

July 18, 2013, Introduced by Reps. Genetski, Somerville, Franz, Howrylak and McMillin and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

A bill to amend 1967 PA 281, entitled
"Income tax act of 1967,"
by repealing part 1 (MCL 206.1 to 206.532).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Enacting section 1. Part 1 of the income tax act of 1967, 1967
2 PA 281, MCL 206.1 to 206.532, is repealed effective January 1,
3 2015. This amendatory act may be referred to as the "taxpayer
4 freedom act".

5 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
6 unless approved by a majority of the electors of this state voting
7 on the question at the next general election to be held in November
8 2014. This amendatory act shall be submitted to the qualified
9 electors of this state at that election as provided by the Michigan

1 election law, 1954 PA 116, MCL 168.1 to 168.992. If approved by the
2 electors, this amendatory act takes effect January 1, 2015.
