A bill to establish a pilot project to accelerate entrepreneurship and innovation by establishing entrepreneur-in-residence positions in the strategic fund.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
 "entrepreneur-in-residence act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
 - (a) "Entrepreneur-in-residence" means an individual appointed to a position under the project.
 - (b) "Project" means the entrepreneur-in-residence project established under this act.
 - (c) "Strategic fund" means the Michigan strategic fund created under the Michigan strategic fund act, 1984 PA 270, MCL 125.2001 to 125.2094.

- 1 Sec. 3. (1) The entrepreneur-in-residence project is

- 3 (2) The project goals include all of the following:
