## **HOUSE BILL No. 5108**

October 29, 2013, Introduced by Reps. Kelly, Singh, LaVoy, Geiss, Franz, Somerville, Genetski, McBroom, Yonker, Heise, Graves and Dianda and referred to the Committee on Criminal Justice.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code," by amending section 465 (MCL 750.465).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 465. (1) The owner, lessee, operator, or manager of each theatre, circus, athletic grounds used for an athletic game, or place of public entertainment or amusement shall have printed on each ticket issued for admission to, or for a seat of, the theatre, circus, athletic grounds, or place of public entertainment or amusement, in conspicuous type, the price of the ticket, and the number on the seat when each seat is IF THE SEATS ARE numbered. The owner, lessee, operator, or manager also shall print or endorse on

- 7 (2) A person owning, occupying, managing, or controlling a

- 11 sale of the ticket to a theatre, circus, athletic grounds, or place
- of public entertainment or amusement, a price in excess of the
- 13 general admission advertised or charged for the same privilege, or
- 14 a person, who by himself or herself or his or her agent or
- 15 employee, offers for sale upon a public place or thoroughfare, a
- 16 ticket to a theatre, circus, athletic grounds, or place of public
- 17 entertainment or amusement, for admission to, or for a seat or
- 18 other privilege in a theatre, circus, athletic grounds, or place of
- 19 public entertainment or amusement, at a price in excess of that
- 20 demanded or received from the general public for the same
- 21 privilege, or in excess of the advertised or printed rate, shall be
- 22 punished as provided in subsection (6), except if the request,
- 23 demand, or receipt is with the written permission of the owner,
- 24 lessee, operator, or manager of the theatre, circus, athletic
- 25 grounds, or place of public entertainment or amusement where the
- 26 event occurs. If the owner, lessee, operator, or manager permits,
- 27 in writing, a charge in excess of the box office price, the

permission shall be limited to the sales of tickets at locations 1 other than the box office where the event occurs. 2 (3) Except as provided in subsections (1) and (2), a person 3 shall not establish an agency or suboffice for the sale of a seat 4 ticket of admission to a theatre, circus, athletic grounds, or 5 place of public entertainment or amusement at a price greater than 6 the sale of a seat ticket at the box office of the theatre, circus, 7 athletic grounds, place of public entertainment or amusement, or in 8 9 excess of the advertised price of the seat ticket. 10 (4) Except as provided in subsections (1) and (2), the owner, 11 lessee, operator, or occupant of a building, room, enclosure, or 12 other place open to the public, who permits a person to sell or 13 exhibit for sale in the building, room, enclosure, or other place open to the public, 1 or more tickets for a theatre, circus, 14 athletic grounds, or place of public entertainment or amusement, 15 for more than the price printed on the ticket, shall be liable and 16 17 guilty equally as the person. 18 (5) If the owner, lessee, operator, or manager of a circus, 19 theatre, athletic grounds, or place of public entertainment or 20 amusement has sold a ticket or admission to a person, under 21 restrictive conditions and at a less rate than the general 22 admission charged, and whose name appears on the face of the ticket or is registered in the office of the owner, lessee, operator, or 23 24 managers as the holder of the ticket and if it is printed on the face of the ticket that the ticket is nontransferable and sold only 25 26 to the person whose name appears on the face of the ticket or is

registered, the holder of the ticket shall not sell the ticket to

- 2 as provided in subsection (6).
- 3 (2) (6) A person who THAT violates this section is guilty of a
- 4 misdemeanor PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 93 DAYS OR
- 5 A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.
