HOUSE BILL No. 5123

October 31, 2013, Introduced by Reps. Cotter and Walsh and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled

"Revised judicature act of 1961,"

by amending sections 518, 8115, and 8121 (MCL 600.518, 600.8115, and 600.8121), section 518 as amended by 2006 PA 99 and section 8121 as amended by 2012 PA 37.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 518. The seventeenth judicial circuit consists of the county of Kent and has 9-10 judges. Subject to section 550, this judicial circuit may have 1 additional judge effective BEGINNING January 1, 2007.2015.
 - Sec. 8115. (1) The EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), THE fifth district consists of the county of Berrien, is a district of the first class, and has 5 judges.

- 1 (2) BEGINNING ON THE EARLIER OF THE FOLLOWING DATES, THE FIFTH
- 2 DISTRICT HAS 4 JUDGES:
- 3 (A) THE DATE ON WHICH A VACANCY OCCURS IN THE OFFICE OF
- 4 DISTRICT JUDGE IN THE FIFTH DISTRICT, UNLESS THE VACANCY OCCURS
- 5 AFTER A JUDGE'S SUCCESSOR IN OFFICE HAS BEEN ELECTED BUT BEFORE
- 6 THAT SUCCESSOR TAKES OFFICE.
- 7 (B) THE BEGINNING DATE OF THE TERM FOR WHICH AN INCUMBENT
- 8 DISTRICT JUDGE IN THE FIFTH DISTRICT NO LONGER SEEKS ELECTION OR
- 9 REELECTION TO THAT OFFICE.
- 10 Sec. 8121. (1) The sixteenth district consists of the city of
- 11 Livonia, is a district of the third class, and has 2 judges.
- 12 (2) The seventeenth district consists of the township of
- 13 Redford in the county of Wayne, is a district of the third class,
- 14 and has 2 judges.
- 15 (3) The eighteenth district consists of the city of Westland,
- 16 is a district of the third class, and has 2 judges.
- 17 (4) The nineteenth district consists of the city of Dearborn,
- 18 is a district of the third class, and has 3 judges.
- 19 (5) The twentieth district consists of the city of Dearborn
- 20 Heights, is a district of the third class, and has 2 judges.
- 21 (6) The twenty-first district consists of the city of Garden
- 22 City, is a district of the third class, and has 1 judge.
- 23 (7) The twenty-second district consists of the city of
- 24 Inkster, is a district of the third class, and has 1 judge.
- 25 (8) The twenty-third district consists of the city of Taylor,
- 26 is a district of the third class, and has 2 judges.
- 27 (9) The twenty-fourth district consists of the cities of Allen

- 1 Park and Melvindale, is a district of the third class, and has 2
- 2 judges.
- 3 (10) The twenty-fifth district consists of the city of Lincoln
- 4 Park, is a district of the third class, and has 2 judges. Beginning
- 5 April 1, 2012, the twenty-fifth district consists of the cities of
- 6 Ecorse, Lincoln Park, and River Rouge, is a district of the third
- 7 class, and has 3 judges. The additional judgeship in the twenty-
- 8 fifth district shall be filled by the incumbent judge of the
- 9 twenty-sixth district, who shall become a judge of the twenty-fifth
- 10 district for the balance of the term to which he or she was elected
- 11 or appointed. Sections 8175 and 8176 do not apply to the
- 12 consolidation of the twenty-fifth and twenty-sixth districts.
- 13 Beginning April 2, 2012, the twenty-fifth district has 2 judges.
- 14 (11) The twenty-sixth district consists of the cities of River
- 15 Rouge and Ecorse, is a district of the third class, and has 1
- 16 judge. Beginning on April 1, 2012, the twenty-sixth district is
- 17 abolished and the judge of the twenty-sixth district shall become a
- 18 judge of the twenty fifth district for the balance of the term to
- 19 which he or she was elected or appointed.
- 20 (11) (12)—The twenty-seventh district consists of the cities
- 21 of Wyandotte and Riverview, is a district of the third class, and
- 22 has 1 judge.
- 23 (12) (13) The EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION,
- 24 THE twenty-eighth district consists of the city of Southgate, is a
- 25 district of the third class, and has 1 judge. IF THE GOVERNING
- 26 BODIES OF THE CITIES OF SOUTHGATE, TRENTON, GIBRALTAR, WOODHAVEN,
- 27 ROCKWOOD, AND FLAT ROCK AND THE TOWNSHIPS OF BROWNSTOWN AND GROSSE

- 1 ILE IN THE COUNTY OF WAYNE APPROVE BY RESOLUTIONS THE CONSOLIDATION
- 2 OF THE TWENTY-EIGHTH AND THIRTY-THIRD DISTRICTS PRIOR TO JANUARY 1,
- 3 2016, ALL OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2016:
- 4 (A) THE THIRTY-THIRD DISTRICT IS ABOLISHED AND THE TWENTY-
- 5 EIGHTH DISTRICT CONSISTS OF THE CITIES OF SOUTHGATE, TRENTON,
- 6 GIBRALTAR, WOODHAVEN, ROCKWOOD, AND FLAT ROCK AND THE TOWNSHIPS OF
- 7 BROWNSTOWN AND GROSSE ILE, IS A DISTRICT OF THE THIRD CLASS, AND
- 8 HAS 4 JUDGES. THE ADDITIONAL JUDGESHIPS IN THE TWENTY-EIGHTH
- 9 DISTRICT SHALL BE FILLED BY THE INCUMBENT JUDGES OF THE THIRTY-
- 10 THIRD DISTRICT, WHO SHALL BECOME JUDGES OF THE TWENTY-EIGHTH
- 11 DISTRICT FOR THE BALANCE OF THE TERM TO WHICH THEY WERE ELECTED OR
- 12 APPOINTED. BEGINNING ON THE EARLIER OF THE FOLLOWING DATES, THE
- 13 TWENTY-EIGHTH DISTRICT SHALL HAVE 3 JUDGES:
- 14 (i) THE DATE ON WHICH A VACANCY OCCURS IN THE OFFICE OF
- 15 DISTRICT JUDGE IN THE TWENTY-EIGHTH DISTRICT, UNLESS THE VACANCY
- 16 OCCURS AFTER A JUDGE'S SUCCESSOR IN OFFICE HAS BEEN ELECTED BUT
- 17 BEFORE THAT SUCCESSOR TAKES OFFICE.
- 18 (ii) THE BEGINNING DATE OF THE TERM FOR WHICH AN INCUMBENT
- 19 DISTRICT JUDGE IN THE TWENTY-EIGHTH DISTRICT NO LONGER SEEKS
- 20 ELECTION OR REELECTION TO THAT OFFICE.
- 21 (B) THE CLERKS OF THE CITIES OF SOUTHGATE, TRENTON, GIBRALTAR,
- 22 WOODHAVEN, ROCKWOOD, AND FLAT ROCK, THE CLERK OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
- 23 REDFORD, AND THE CLERKS OF THE TOWNSHIPS OF BROWNSTOWN AND GROSSE
- 24 ILE SHALL FILE COPIES OF THE RESOLUTIONS WITH THE STATE COURT
- 25 ADMINISTRATOR, WHO, AS AUTHORIZED BY THE SUPREME COURT, SHALL
- 26 NOTIFY THE ELECTIONS DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE THAT THE
- 27 CONSOLIDATION HAS BEEN APPROVED UNDER THIS SECTION.

- 1 (C) BY PROPOSING OR AUTHORIZING THE CONSOLIDATION OF THE
- 2 TWENTY-EIGHTH AND THIRTY-THIRD DISTRICTS, THE LEGISLATURE IS NOT
- 3 CREATING A NEW OBLIGATION FOR ANY AFFECTED DISTRICT CONTROL UNIT.
- 4 IF A DISTRICT CONTROL UNIT, ACTING THROUGH ITS GOVERNING BODY,
- 5 APPROVES THE CONSOLIDATION, THEN THE APPROVAL CONSTITUTES AN
- 6 EXERCISE OF THE DISTRICT CONTROL UNIT'S OPTION TO INCREASE THE
- 7 LEVEL OF ACTIVITY AND SERVICE OFFERED IN THAT DISTRICT CONTROL UNIT
- 8 BEYOND THAT REQUIRED BY EXISTING LAW, AS THE ELEMENTS OF THAT
- 9 OPTION ARE PROVIDED BY 1979 PA 101, MCL 21.231 TO 21.244, AND A
- 10 VOLUNTARY ACCEPTANCE BY THAT DISTRICT CONTROL UNIT OF ALL EXPENSES
- 11 AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS THAT MAY RESULT FROM THE CONSOLIDATION OF
- 12 THE DISTRICTS. HOWEVER, THE EXERCISE OF THE OPTION DOES NOT AFFECT
- 13 THE STATE'S OBLIGATION TO PAY THE SAME PORTION OF EACH JUDGE'S
- 14 SALARY THAT IS PAID BY THE STATE TO OTHER DISTRICT JUDGES AS
- 15 PROVIDED BY LAW, OR TO APPROPRIATE AND DISBURSE FUNDS TO THE
- 16 DISTRICT CONTROL UNIT FOR THE NECESSARY COSTS OF STATE REQUIREMENTS
- 17 ESTABLISHED BY A STATE LAW THAT BECOMES EFFECTIVE ON OR AFTER
- 18 DECEMBER 23, 1978.
- 19 (13) (14)—The twenty-ninth district consists of the city of
- 20 Wayne, is a district of the third class, and has 1 judge.
- 21 (14) (15)—The thirtieth district consists of the city of
- 22 Highland Park, is a district of the third class, and has 1 judge.
- 23 (15) (16)—The thirty-first district consists of the city of
- 24 Hamtramck, is a district of the third class, and has 1 judge.
- 25 (16) (17)—The thirty-second-a district consists of the city of
- 26 Harper Woods, is a district of the third class, and has 1 judge.
- 27 (17) (18)—The thirty-second-b district consists of the cities

- 1 of Grosse Pointe Woods, Grosse Pointe Park, Grosse Pointe, and
- 2 Grosse Pointe Farms, and the village of Grosse Pointe Shores, is a
- 3 district of the third class, and has 1 judge.
- 4 (18) (19) The EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (12), THE
- 5 thirty-third district consists of the cities of Trenton, Gibraltar,
- 6 Woodhaven, Rockwood, and Flat Rock and the townships of Brownstown
- 7 and Grosse Ile in the county of Wayne, is a district of the third
- 8 class, and has the following number of judges:
- 9 (a) Until the date determined under subdivision (b), 3 judges.
- 10 (b) Beginning on the earlier of the following dates, 2 judges:
- 11 (i) The date on which a vacancy occurs in the office of
- 12 district judge in this district, UNLESS THE VACANCY OCCURS AFTER A
- 13 JUDGE'S SUCCESSOR IN OFFICE HAS BEEN ELECTED BUT BEFORE THAT
- 14 SUCCESSOR TAKES OFFICE.
- 15 (ii) The beginning date of the term for which an incumbent
- 16 district judge in this district no longer seeks election or
- 17 reelection to that office.
- 18 (19) (20)—The thirty-fourth district consists of the townships
- 19 of Sumpter, Van Buren, and Huron in the county of Wayne and the
- 20 cities of Romulus and Belleville, is a district of the third class,
- 21 and has 3 judges.
- 22 (20) (21) The thirty-fifth district consists of the cities of
- 23 Northville and Plymouth and the townships of Northville, Plymouth,
- 24 and Canton in the county of Wayne, is a district of the third
- 25 class, and has 3 judges.
- 26 Enacting section 1. Section 8121 of the revised judicature act
- 27 of 1961, 1961 PA 236, MCL 600.8121, as amended by this amendatory

1 act, takes effect on January 2, 2015.
