A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1307.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1307. (1) IF A SCHOOL OFFICIAL OR OTHER INDIVIDUAL
- 2 EMPLOYED AT A PUBLIC SCHOOL WITNESSES OR RECEIVES INFORMATION
- 3 REGARDING AN INCIDENT THAT MAY CONSTITUTE MALTREATMENT OR INJURY OF
- A CHILD AT SCHOOL, THEN, AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE AFTER WITNESSING
- 5 THE INCIDENT OR RECEIVING THE INFORMATION, THE SCHOOL OFFICIAL OR
- 6 OTHER INDIVIDUAL SHALL INFORM THE PARENT, LEGAL GUARDIAN, OR
- 7 CUSTODIAN OF THE CHILD IN WRITING OF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 8 (A) THAT AN INCIDENT HAS OCCURRED THAT MAY CONSTITUTE
- MALTREATMENT OR INJURY OF THE CHILD AT SCHOOL.

- 12 RELATED VEHICLE, OR AT A SCHOOL-SPONSORED ACTIVITY OR EVENT WHETHER
- 13 OR NOT IT IS HELD ON SCHOOL PREMISES.
