A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled

"The Michigan penal code,"

by amending sections 449a, 451, 452, 455, 456, 457, 458, 459, and 460 (MCL 750.449a, 750.451, 750.452, 750.455, 750.456, 750.457, 750.458, 750.459, and 750.460), section 451 as amended by 2002 PA 44.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 449a. Any male—person who engages or offers to engage the
services of a female—ANOTHER person , not his wife, for the purpose
of prostitution, lewdness, or assignation, by the payment in money
or ANY other forms—FORM of consideration, is guilty of a
misdemeanor—CRIME PUNISHABLE AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 451. Any person
convicted of violating this section shall be subject to the

- 1 provisions of Act No. 6 of the Public Acts of the Second Extra
- 2 Session of 1942, being sections 329.201 to 329.208 of the Compiled
- 3 Laws of 1948.
- 4 Sec. 451. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a
- 5 person convicted of violating section 448, 449, 449a, 450, or 462
- 6 is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more
- 7 than 93 days or a fine of not more than \$500.00, or both.
- 8 (2) A-EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (5), A person 16 years
- 9 of age or older who is convicted of violating section 448, 449,
- 10 449a, 450, or 462 and who has 1 prior conviction is guilty of a
- 11 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 1 year or
- 12 a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both.
- 13 (3) A EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (5), A person convicted
- 14 of violating section 448, 449, 449a, 450, or 462 and who has 2 or
- 15 more prior convictions is guilty of a felony punishable by
- 16 imprisonment for not more than 2 years —or a fine of not more than

- 7 VIOLATION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT
- 8 MORE THAN 4 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.00, OR BOTH.

- 10 violation of section 448, 449, 449a, 450, or 462 or a violation of
- 11 a law of another state or of a political subdivision of this state
- 12 or another state substantially corresponding to section 448, 449,

- 14 Sec. 452. Keeping, etc., a house of ill-fame-Any-A person who
- 15 shall keep, maintain KEEPS, MAINTAINS, or operate, OPERATES, or aid
- 16 AIDS and abet ABETS in keeping, maintaining, or operating, a house
- 17 of ill-fame, bawdy house, or any house or place resorted to for the
- 18 purpose of prostitution or lewdness shall be—IS guilty of a felony
- 19 punishable by imprisonment in the state prison—for not more than
- 20 5 years or by a fine of not more than 2,500 dollars.\$5,000.00, OR
- 21 BOTH.
- 22 Sec. 455. Pandering Any A person who shall procure a female
- 23 DOES ANY OF THE FOLLOWING IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY
- 24 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 20 YEARS:
- 25 (A) PROCURES AN inmate for a house of prostitution. ; or who
- 26 shall induce, persuade, encourage, inveigle or entice a female
- 27 (B) INDUCES, PERSUADES, ENCOURAGES, INVEIGLES, OR ENTICES A

- 10 (D) BY ANY PROMISE OR THREAT, OR BY violence or by any device
- 11 or scheme, cause, induce, persuade, encourage, inveigle or entice
- 12 CAUSES, INDUCES, PERSUADES, ENCOURAGES, INVEIGLES, OR ENTICES an
- 13 inmate of a house of prostitution or place of assignation to remain
- 14 therein THERE as such AN inmate. ; or any person who by promises,
- 15 threats,
- 16 (E) BY ANY PROMISE OR THREAT, OR BY violence, by any device or
- 17 scheme, by fraud or artifice, or by duress of person or goods, or
- 18 by abuse of any position of confidence or authority, or having
- 19 legal charge, shall take, place, harbor, inveigle, entice,
- 20 persuade, encourage TAKES, PLACES, HARBORS, INVEIGLES, ENTICES,
- 21 PERSUADES, ENCOURAGES, or procure PROCURES any female person to
- 22 enter any place within this state in which prostitution is
- 23 practiced, encouraged or allowed, for the purpose of ENGAGE IN
- 24 prostitution. ; or who shall inveigle, entice, persuade, encourage,
- 25 or procure
- 26 (F) INVEIGLES, ENTICES, PERSUADES, ENCOURAGES, OR PROCURES any
- 27 female—person to come into this state or to leave this state for

- 1 the purpose of prostitution. ; or who upon
- 2 (G) UPON the pretense of marriage, takes or detains a female
- 3 person for the purpose of sexual intercourse. ; or who shall
- 4 receive or give or agree
- 5 (H) RECEIVES OR GIVES, OR AGREES to receive or give, any money
- 6 or thing of value for procuring or attempting to procure any female
- 7 person to become a prostitute or to come into this state or leave
- 8 this state for the purpose of prostitution. , shall be guilty of a
- 9 felony, punishable by imprisonment in the state prison for not more
- 10 than 20 years.
- 11 Sec. 456. Placing wife by fraud, etc., in house of
- 12 prostitution Any ANY person who by force, fraud, intimidation, or
- 13 threat places or leaves, or procures any other person to place or
- 14 leave, his wife OR HER SPOUSE in a house of prostitution or to lead
- 15 a life of prostitution, shall be IS guilty of a felony , punishable
- 16 by imprisonment in the state prison for not more than 20 years.
- 17 Sec. 457. (1) Accepting money, etc., from earnings of
- 18 prostitute Any ANY person who shall knowingly accept, receive, levy
- 19 ACCEPTS, RECEIVES, LEVIES, or appropriate APPROPRIATES any money or
- 20 valuable thing without consideration from the proceeds of the
- 21 earnings of any woman PERSON engaged in prostitution, or any
- 22 person, knowing a female PERSON to be a prostitute, shall live WHO
- 23 LIVES or derive DERIVES support or maintenance, in whole or in
- 24 part, from the earnings or proceeds of the prostitution of said A
- 25 prostitute, or from moneys MONEY loaned or advanced to or charged
- 26 against her A PROSTITUTE by any keeper or manager or inmate of a
- 27 house or other place where prostitution is practiced or allowed,

- 1 shall be IS guilty of a felony , punishable by imprisonment in the
- 2 state prison FOR not more than 20 years. And such
- 3 (2) THE acceptance, receipt, levy, or appropriation of such
- 4 money or valuable ANY thing , shall, upon any proceeding or trial
- 5 for violation of this section, be OF VALUE DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION
- 6 (1) IS presumptive evidence of lack of consideration.
- 7 Sec. 458. Detaining female in house of prostitution for debt
- 8 contracted while there Any ANY person who attempts to detain any
- 9 female person in a disorderly house or house of prostitution
- 10 because of any debt or debts she THE PERSON has contracted, or is
- 11 said to have contracted while living in said-THAT house, shall be
- 12 IS guilty of a felony , punishable by imprisonment in the state
- 13 prison for not less than 2 nor YEARS OR more than 20 years.
- 14 Sec. 459. (1) Transporting female for prostitution—Any A
- 15 person who shall knowingly transport TRANSPORTS or cause CAUSES to
- 16 be transported, or aid AIDS or assist ASSISTS in obtaining
- 17 transportation for, by any means of conveyance, into, through or
- 18 across this state, any female person for the purpose of
- 19 prostitution or with the intent and purpose to induce, entice or
- 20 compel such female_THAT person to become a prostitute shall be-IS
- 21 guilty of a felony, punishable by imprisonment in the state prison
- 22 for not more than 20 years. ; any
- 23 (2) A person who may commit the crime in VIOLATES this section
- 24 mentioned may be prosecuted, indicted, tried, and convicted in any
- 25 county or city in or through which he shall so transport or attempt
- 26 to transport any female person as aforesaid. IN VIOLATION OF THIS
- 27 SECTION.

- 1 Sec. 460. (1) Acts committed outside state—It shall—IT IS not
- 2 be a defense to a prosecution for any of the acts prohibited in the
- 3 next 5 preceding sections A VIOLATION of this chapter that any part
- 4 of such act or acts shall have been THAT VIOLATION WAS committed
- 5 outside this state. , and the offense shall in such case be deemed
- 6 and alleged to have been committed and the offender
- 7 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS CHAPTER MAY BE tried and
- 8 punished in any county in which the prostitution was intended to be
- 9 practiced, or in which the offense was consummated, or IN WHICH any
- 10 overt act in furtherance of the offense shall have been WAS
- 11 committed.
