HOUSE BILL No. 5234

January 22, 2014, Introduced by Reps. Jenkins, Heise, Haines, Lamonte, Hovey-Wright, LaVoy, Lauwers, Price, Rogers, Slavens, Darany, Singh, Brinks, Haveman, Kowall, Zorn, Cavanagh, O'Brien, Barnett, Driskell, Haugh, Roberts, Brown, Banks, Lyons, Kivela, Tlaib, McCready, Irwin and Lane and referred to the Committee on Criminal Justice.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending sections 156, 462a, 462b, 462c, 462d, 462e, 462f, 462g, and 462h (MCL 750.156, 750.462a, 750.462b, 750.462c, 750.462d, 750.462e, 750.462f, 750.462g, and 750.462h), sections 462a, 462b, 462c, 462d, 462e, 462f, 462g, and 462h as added by 2006 PA 162; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 156. (1) Exemptions The provisions of this THIS chapter shall DOES not apply to agricultural products or live stock

LIVESTOCK while in the hands of the producer or raiser , nor OR to the services of laborers or artisans who are formed into societies or organizations for the benefit and protection of their members.

(2) THIS CHAPTER DOES NOT APPLY TO CONSPIRACY COMMITTED UNDER CHAPTER LXVIIA.

- 2 OF A VICTIM NEED NOT BE CORROBORATED IN A PROSECUTION UNDER THIS
- 3 CHAPTER.
- 4 Sec. 462h. (1) A person shall not knowingly do 1 or both of

- 6 (a) Recruit, entice, harbor, transport, provide, or obtain by
- 7 any means, or attempt to recruit, entice, harbor, transport,
- 8 provide, or obtain by any means, another person, intending or
- 9 knowing that the person will be subjected to forced labor or
- 10 services.
- 11 (b) Benefit financially or receive anything of value from
- 12 participation in a venture that has engaged in an act described in
- 13 this chapter.
- 14 (2) Except as provided in subsections (3) and (4), a person
- 15 who violates subsection (1) is guilty of a felony punishable by
- 16 imprisonment for not more than 10 years.
