

# HOUSE BILL No. 5501

April 30, 2014, Introduced by Reps. Talabi, Haveman, Durhal, Zemke, Brown, Stallworth, Smiley, Cavanagh, Banks, Slavens, Stanley, Callton, Kesto, Price, Barnett, Abed, Lipton and Robinson and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 2008 PA 23, entitled

"Enhanced driver license and enhanced official state personal identification card act,"

by amending section 4 (MCL 28.304).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 4. (1) The secretary of state may issue an enhanced  
2 driver's license or enhanced official state personal identification  
3 card to an applicant who provides satisfactory proof of his or her  
4 full legal name, United States citizenship, identity, date of  
5 birth, social security number, residence address, and a  
6 photographic identity document. An applicant may choose to apply  
7 for a standard driver license or standard official state personal  
8 identification card or an enhanced driver license or enhanced state

1 personal identification card.

2 (2) An enhanced driver license or enhanced official state  
3 personal identification card shall include reasonable security  
4 measures to protect against unauthorized disclosure of personal  
5 information regarding residents of this state that is contained in  
6 the enhanced driver license or enhanced official state personal  
7 identification card.

8 (3) An enhanced driver license or enhanced official state  
9 personal identification card may include radio frequency  
10 identification technology that is limited to a randomly assigned  
11 number which shall be encrypted if agreed to by the department of  
12 homeland security, and does not include biometric data. The  
13 secretary of state shall ensure that the radio frequency  
14 identification technology is secure from unauthorized data access  
15 and includes reasonable security measures to protect against  
16 unauthorized disclosure of personal information. An applicant shall  
17 be required to sign a declaration acknowledging his or her  
18 understanding of the radio frequency identification technology  
19 before he or she is issued an enhanced driver license or enhanced  
20 official state personal identification card.

21 (4) The requirements of this act are in addition to the  
22 requirements otherwise imposed on individuals who apply for a  
23 standard driver license or standard official state personal  
24 identification card.

25 (5) The holder of an enhanced driver license issued under this  
26 act is subject to every licensing sanction provided under the  
27 Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923. As used

1 in this subsection, "licensing sanction" means the restriction,  
2 suspension, revocation, or denial of a driver license; the addition  
3 of points to a driving record; ~~the assessment of a driver~~  
4 ~~responsibility fee;~~ the assessment of a civil fine or criminal  
5 penalty resulting from a conviction; a civil infraction  
6 determination; the imposition of probationary terms and conditions;  
7 or any other penalty provided under the Michigan vehicle code, 1949  
8 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923.

9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect October  
10 1, 2017.

11 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect  
12 unless House Bill No. 5414 of the 97th Legislature is enacted into  
13 law.
