A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled
"The insurance code of 1956,"

(MCL 500.100 to 500.8302) by adding section 2035a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 2035A. (1) THE INSURANCE WHISTLEBLOWER PROTECTION FUND IS 2 CREATED WITHIN THE STATE TREASURY.
  - (2) THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE INSURANCE WHISTLEBLOWER PROTECTION FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE INSURANCE WHISTLEBLOWER PROTECTION FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL

CREDIT TO THE INSURANCE WHISTLEBLOWER PROTECTION FUND INTEREST AND

EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS.
