

# HOUSE BILL No. 5614

May 29, 2014, Introduced by Reps. Singh and Howrylak and referred to the Committee on Criminal Justice.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled  
"Michigan vehicle code,"  
by amending section 601d (MCL 257.601d), as added by 2008 PA 463.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 601d. (1) A person who commits a moving violation **WHILE**  
2 **OPERATING A VEHICLE UPON A HIGHWAY OR A FROZEN PUBLIC LAKE, STREAM,**  
3 **OR POND OR OTHER PLACE OPEN TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC, INCLUDING, BUT**  
4 **NOT LIMITED TO, AN AREA DESIGNATED FOR THE PARKING OF MOTOR**  
5 **VEHICLES,** that causes the death of another person is guilty of a  
6 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 1 year or  
7 a fine of not more than \$2,000.00, or both.

8           (2) A person who commits a moving violation **WHILE OPERATING A**  
9 **VEHICLE UPON A HIGHWAY OR A FROZEN PUBLIC LAKE, STREAM, OR POND OR**  
10 **OTHER PLACE OPEN TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED**

1 TO, AN AREA DESIGNATED FOR THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES, that  
2 causes serious impairment of a body function to another person is  
3 guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more  
4 than 93 days or a fine of not more than \$500.00, or both.

5 (3) This section does not prohibit the person from being  
6 charged with, convicted of, or punished for any other violation of  
7 law.

8 (4) As used in this section, "moving violation" means an act  
9 or omission prohibited under this act or a local ordinance  
10 substantially corresponding to this act that involves the operation  
11 of a motor vehicle, and for which a fine may be assessed.
