HOUSE BILL No. 5808

September 16, 2014, Introduced by Rep. McMillin and referred to the Committee on Oversight.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 442, entitled

"Freedom of information act,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 15.232), as amended by 1996 PA 553.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Field name" means the label or identification of an
 3 element of a computer data base that contains a specific item of
 4 information, and includes but is not limited to a subject heading
 5 such as a column header, data dictionary, or record layout.
 - (b) "FOIA coordinator" means either of the following:
 - (i) An individual who is a public body.
 - (ii) An individual designated by a public body in accordance with section 6 to accept and process requests for public records

- 2 (c) "Person" means an individual, corporation, limited
- 3 liability company, partnership, firm, organization, association,
- 4 governmental entity, or other legal entity. Person does not include
- 5 an individual serving a sentence of imprisonment in a state or
- 6 county correctional facility in this state or any other state, or
- 7 in a federal correctional facility.
- 8 (d) "Public body" means any of the following:
- 9 (i) A state officer, employee, agency, department, division,
- 10 bureau, board, commission, council, authority, or other body in the
- 11 executive branch of the state government, but does not include the
- 12 governor or lieutenant governor, the executive office of the
- 13 governor or lieutenant governor, or employees thereof.
- 14 (ii) An agency, board, commission, or council in the
- 15 legislative branch of the state government.
- 16 (iii) A county, city, township, village, intercounty, intercity,
- 17 or regional governing body, council, school district, special
- 18 district, or municipal corporation, or a board, department,
- 19 commission, council, or agency thereof.
- (iv) Any other body which is created by state or local
- 21 authority or which is primarily funded by or through state or local
- 22 authority, INCLUDING AN ORGANIZATION UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF, AND
- 23 CREATED FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PURPOSES BY, A LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL
- 24 UNIT, SUCH AS AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION CREATED UNDER THE
- 25 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATIONS ACT, 1974 PA 338, MCL 125.1601 TO

- (v) The judiciary, including the office of the county clerk

- 1 and employees thereof when acting in the capacity of clerk to the
- 2 circuit court, is not included in the definition of public body.
- 3 (e) "Public record" means a writing prepared, owned, used, in
- 4 the possession of, or retained by a public body in the performance
- 5 of an official function, from the time it is created. Public record
- 6 does not include computer software. This act separates public
- 7 records into the following 2 classes:
- **8** (i) Those that are exempt from disclosure under section 13.
- 9 (ii) All public records that are not exempt from disclosure
- 10 under section 13 and which are subject to disclosure under this
- **11** act.
- 12 (f) "Software" means a set of statements or instructions that
- 13 when incorporated in a machine usable medium is capable of causing
- 14 a machine or device having information processing capabilities to
- 15 indicate, perform, or achieve a particular function, task, or
- 16 result. Software does not include computer-stored information or
- 17 data, or a field name if disclosure of that field name does not
- 18 violate a software license.
- 19 (g) "Unusual circumstances" means any 1 or a combination of
- 20 the following, but only to the extent necessary for the proper
- 21 processing of a request:
- 22 (i) The need to search for, collect, or appropriately examine
- 23 or review a voluminous amount of separate and distinct public
- 24 records pursuant to a single request.
- 25 (ii) The need to collect the requested public records from
- 26 numerous field offices, facilities, or other establishments which
- 27 are located apart from the particular office receiving or

- processing the request.
- 2 (h) "Writing" means handwriting, typewriting, printing,
- 3 photostating, photographing, photocopying, and every other means of
- 4 recording, and includes letters, words, pictures, sounds, or
- 5 symbols, or combinations thereof, and papers, maps, magnetic or
- 6 paper tapes, photographic films or prints, microfilm, microfiche,
- 7 magnetic or punched cards, discs, drums, or other means of
- 8 recording or retaining meaningful content.
- 9 (i) "Written request" means a writing that asks for
- 10 information, and includes a writing transmitted by facsimile,
- 11 electronic mail, or other electronic means.
