A bill to amend 1976 PA 453, entitled "Elliott-Larsen civil rights act,"

by amending section 602 (MCL 37.2602), as amended by 1992 PA 258.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 602. (1) The department shall DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
 - (a) Be responsible to the executive director, who shall be IS the principal executive officer of the department and shall be IS responsible for executing the policies of the commission.
 - (b) Appoint necessary employees and agents and fix their compensation in accordance with civil service rules. The attorney general shall appear for and represent the department or the commission in a court having jurisdiction of a matter under this act.
 - (c) Receive, initiate, investigate, conciliate, adjust,

- 1 dispose of, issue charges, and hold hearings on complaints alleging
- 2 a violation of this act, and approve or disapprove plans to correct
- 3 past discriminatory practices which have caused or resulted in a
- 4 denial of equal opportunity with respect to groups or persons

- 6 (d) Require answers to interrogatories, order the submission

- 18 VICTIM OF SEXUAL HARASSMENT DESCRIBED IN A COMPLAINT FILED WITH THE
- 19 DEPARTMENT, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL KEEP THE IDENTITY OF THE
- 20 INDIVIDUAL CONFIDENTIAL. THE IDENTITY OF AN ALLEGED VICTIM OF
- 21 SEXUAL HARASSMENT IN A COMPLAINT FILED WITH THE DEPARTMENT IS
- 22 EXEMPT FROM DISCLOSURE UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT, 1976
