

HOUSE BILL No. 5997

December 2, 2014, Introduced by Rep. Price and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend 1959 PA 54, entitled

"An act to provide for the disposition and sale of certain stolen property recovered by any county sheriff; and to provide for the disposition of the proceeds of sale and certain other property,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 434.172), as amended by 1984 PA 257.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 2. The county board of commissioners shall act upon the
2 request of the sheriff within 6 months after ~~the receipt of~~
3 **RECEIVING** the request. ~~IF~~**BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2015, IF** the board
4 approves the request, the sheriff shall publish notice in a
5 newspaper of general circulation in the county at least 5 days
6 before the sale. **BEGINNING JANUARY 15, 2015, THE PUBLIC NOTICE**
7 **SHALL BE TIER B WITH A LINK NOTICE AS PROVIDED IN THE LOCAL**
8 **GOVERNMENT PUBLIC NOTICE ACT AT LEAST 5 DAYS BEFORE THE SALE.** The

1 notice shall describe the property, including money, and shall
2 state the time and place of public sale at which the property may
3 be purchased by the highest bidder. The sheriff may obtain an
4 appraisal to determine whether money, because of age, origin, metal
5 content, or value as a collector's item, has a value other than its
6 face value. Money ~~which~~**THAT** does not have a value other than its
7 face value ~~shall~~**IS** not ~~be~~ subject to the public sale provisions
8 contained in this section. Until the date of the sale the property,
9 including money, may be claimed at the sheriff's office. If
10 ownership is proved, the sheriff shall turn the property, including
11 money, over to the owner and cancel the sale insofar as the claimed
12 property is concerned.

13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
14 unless Senate Bill No.____ or House Bill No. 5560 (request no.
15 03796'13) of the 97th Legislature is enacted into law.
