HOUSE BILL No. 5998

December 2, 2014, Introduced by Rep. Price and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend 1979 PA 214, entitled

"An act to provide for the disposition and sale of certain stolen or abandoned property recovered or discovered within a city, village, or township; and to provide for the disposition of the proceeds of sale and certain other property,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 434.182), as amended by 1984 PA 258.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 2. (1) The village council or township board of trustees shall act upon the request of the law enforcement officer within not less than 60 days after the receipt of RECEIVING the request and not more than 6 months after the receipt of RECEIVING the request.
 - (2) If the village council or township board of trustees authorizes the law enforcement officer to give the property to the

- 1 sheriff of the county, the law enforcement officer shall deliver
- 2 the property to the sheriff within 10 days.
- 3 (3) If the village council or township board of trustees
- 4 authorizes the law enforcement officer to dispose of the property

- 6 conduct a sale of the property in the manner provided in subsection

- 8 (4) The BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2015, THE law enforcement officer

- 13 LOCAL GOVERNMENT PUBLIC NOTICE ACT NOT LESS THAN 5 DAYS BEFORE THE
- 14 PROPOSED SALE OF THE PROPERTY. The notice shall describe the
- 15 property, including money, and shall state the time and place of
- 16 the public sale at which the property may be purchased by the
- 17 highest bidder. The law enforcement officer may obtain an appraisal
- 18 to determine whether money, because of age, origin, metal content,
- 19 or value as a collector's item, has a value other than its face
- 20 value. Money which THAT does not have a value other than its face
- 21 value shall—IS not be—subject to the public sale provisions
- 22 contained in this section. Until the date of the sale, the property
- 23 may be claimed at the office of the law enforcement officer. If
- 24 ownership of the property is proved, the property shall be turned
- 25 over to the owner and the sale shall be canceled insofar as the
- 26 claimed property is concerned.
