## **HOUSE BILL No. 6031**

December 2, 2014, Introduced by Rep. Price and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 252g (MCL 257.252g), as amended by 2012 PA 498.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 252g. (1) Subject to section 252a(16), a public sale for a vehicle and its contents that has been determined to be abandoned under section 252a or removed under section 252d shall be conducted in the following manner:
  - (a) It shall be under the control of the police agency.
  - However, a police agency may designate the custodian of the vehicle or a third party to conduct the auction.
    - (b) It shall be open to the public and consist of open auction

- 1 bidding or bidding by sealed bids. If sealed bids are received, the
- 2 person submitting the bid shall receive a receipt for the bid from
- 3 the police agency or the agency's designee or, if the vehicle is
- 4 being sold under section 252a(16), the custodian of the vehicle.
- 5 (c) Except as otherwise provided in sections 252a(16) and (17)
- 6 and 252b(7), 252B(8), it shall be held not less than 5 days after
- 7 public notice of the sale has been published.
- 8 (d) The BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2015, THE public notice shall be
- 9 published at least once in a newspaper having a general circulation
- 10 within the county in which the vehicle was abandoned. BEGINNING
- 11 JANUARY 15, 2015, THE PUBLIC NOTICE SHALL BE TIER B WITH A LINK
- 12 NOTICE AS PROVIDED IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT PUBLIC NOTICE ACT. The
- 13 public notice shall give a description of the vehicle for sale and
- 14 shall state the time, date, and location of the sale.
- 15 (2) The money received from the public sale of the vehicle
- shall be applied in the following order of priority:
- 17 (a) Accrued towing and storage charges. However, if the money
- 18 received from the public sale does not satisfy the accrued towing
- 19 and storage charges, the towing company may collect the balance of
- 20 those unpaid fees from the last titled owner, subject to section
- **21** 252i.
- (b) Expenses incurred by the police agency or the custodian of
- 23 the vehicle.
- (c) Payment of the \$40.00 abandoned vehicle fee described in
- 25 section 252f(3)(a).252B(8) TO (10).
- 26 (d) Any extra money shall be sent to the department of
- 27 treasury's unclaimed property division to be disbursed as follows:

- ${f 1}$  (i) To the secured party, if any, in the amount of the debt
- 2 outstanding on the vehicle.
- (ii) Remainder to the owner. A reasonable attempt shall be made
- 4 to mail the remainder to the last titled owner. If delivery of the
- 5 remainder cannot be accomplished, the remainder shall become the
- 6 property of the unit of government governing the location from
- 7 which the vehicle was towed.
- 8 (3) If there are no bidders on the vehicle, the police agency
- 9 or the custodian of the vehicle may do 1 of the following:
- 10 (a) Turn the vehicle over to the towing firm or the custodian
- 11 of the vehicle to satisfy charges against the vehicle. However, if
- 12 the value of the vehicle does not satisfy the towing fees and
- 13 accrued daily storage fees, the custodian of the vehicle may
- 14 collect the balance of those unpaid fees from the last titled
- 15 owner, subject to section 252i.
- 16 (b) Obtain title to the vehicle for the police agency or the
- 17 unit of government the police agency represents, by doing the
- 18 following:
- (i) Paying the towing and storage charges.
- 20 (ii) Applying for title to the vehicle.
- (c) Hold another public sale under subsection (1).
- 22 (4) A person who acquires ownership of a vehicle under
- 23 subsection (1) or (3) that has been designated as a distressed
- 24 vehicle shall apply for a salvage certificate of title within 15
- 25 days after obtaining the vehicle.
- 26 (5) Upon disposition of the vehicle, the police agency or
- 27 towing agency or custodian shall provide the secretary of state and

- 1 the police agency, if that police agency did not conduct the sale,
- 2 with the vehicle's disposition and the name of the agency that
- 3 disposed of it and the police agency shall cancel the entry in the
- 4 law enforcement information network.
- **5** (6) Not less than 25 days after the date of notice required
- 6 under section 252a, if the police agency does not provide a copy of
- 7 the bill of sale by the police agency for the abandoned vehicle to
- 8 the towing agency or custodian or police agency's designee, the
- 9 towing agency or custodian or police agency designee may obtain an
- 10 original of the bill of sale by submitting an application to the
- 11 secretary of state in a form as determined by the secretary of
- 12 state.
- 13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 14 unless Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. 5560 (request no.
- 15 03796'13) of the 97th Legislature is enacted into law.
