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## **HOUSE BILL No. 6049**

December 2, 2014, Introduced by Rep. Price and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend 1963 PA 62, entitled "Industrial development revenue bond act of 1963," by amending section 5 (MCL 125.1255).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 5. (1) Any resolution authorizing the issuance of bonds under this act may contain covenants as to 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- (a) The use and disposition of the rentals received under the agreement, including the creation and maintenance of reserves.
- (b) The issuance of other or additional bonds payable from the income and revenues from the industrial building and site and any industrial machinery and equipment.

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- 1 (c) The maintenance and repair costs of the industrial
- 2 building and site and any industrial machinery and equipment, which
- 3 costs may be assumed by the lessee, person, firm, or corporation,
- 4 in which event no provision need be made for rental payments to
- 5 meet said THE costs.
- 6 (d) The insurance to be carried thereon ON THE BONDS and the
- 7 use and disposition of insurance moneys. MONEY.
- 8 (e) The terms and conditions upon which the holder of the
- 9 bonds, or any portion thereof OF THE BONDS or any trustees,
- 10 therefor, shall be entitled to the appointment of a receiver by the
- 11 circuit court, which court shall have jurisdiction in such THE
- 12 proceedings, and which receiver may enter and take possession of
- 13 the industrial building and site and any industrial machinery and
- 14 equipment and lease and maintain it, prescribe rentals, and
- 15 collect, receive, and apply all income and revenues thereafter
- 16 arising therefrom in the same manner and to the same extent as the
- 17 municipality might do.
- 18 (2) Any resolution authorizing the issuance of bonds under
- 19 this act may provide that the principal of and interest on any
- 20 bonds issued shall be secured by a mortgage or deed of trust
- 21 covering the industrial building and site and any industrial
- 22 machinery and equipment for which the bonds are issued and may
- 23 include any additions, improvements, or extensions thereafter made.
- 24 The mortgage or deed of trust may contain such covenants and
- 25 agreements to properly safeguard the bonds as may be provided for
- 26 in the resolution authorizing the bonds but not inconsistent with
- 27 this act and shall be executed in the manner provided in the

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- 1 resolution. The resolution may provide for the appointment of 1 or
- 2 more trustees for bondholders, and any such trustee may be an
- 3 individual or corporation domiciled or located within or without
- 4 the state and may be given appropriate powers whether with or
- 5 without the execution of a mortgage or deed of trust covering the
- 6 industrial building or site or industrial machinery and equipment.
- 7 (3) The provisions of this act and any resolution and any
- 8 mortgage or deed of trust shall continue in effect until the
- 9 principal of and the interest on the bonds has been fully paid, and
- 10 the duties of the municipality and its governing body and officers
- 11 under this act and any resolution and any mortgage or deed of trust
- 12 shall be enforceable by any bondholder by mandamus, foreclosure of
- 13 the mortgage or deed of trust, or other appropriate action in any
- 14 court of competent jurisdiction.
- 15 (4) The resolution authorizing the bond shall provide that the
- 16 bonds shall contain a recital that they are issued pursuant to this
- 17 act, which recital shall be conclusive evidence of their validity
- 18 and of the regularity of their issuance.
- 19 (5) Any THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2014, ANY resolution authorizing
- 20 the issuance of bonds under this act shall not be effective until
- 21 publication once in a newspaper of general circulation within the
- 22 municipality. BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2015, ANY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING
- 23 THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS UNDER THIS ACT SHALL NOT BE EFFECTIVE UNTIL
- 24 THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE MUNICIPALITY PROVIDES TIER A PUBLIC
- 25 NOTICE AS PROVIDED IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT PUBLIC NOTICE ACT.
- 26 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 27 unless Senate Bill No. \_\_\_ or House Bill No. 5560 (request no.
