

SENATE BILL No. 129

January 31, 2013, Introduced by Senators GREGORY, HOOD, SMITH, BIEDA, JOHNSON, HOPGOOD, ANDERSON, YOUNG, HUNTER and MOOLENAAR and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," (MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 811u.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 811U. (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEVELOP UNDER
2 SECTION 811E AND ISSUE UNDER SECTION 811F A FUND-RAISING PLATE
3 RECOGNIZING WOMEN VETERANS. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DESIGN THE
4 FUND-RAISING PLATES AUTHORIZED IN THIS SECTION.

5 (2) THE WOMEN VETERANS FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE STATE
6 TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS
7 FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER
8 SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL
9 CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS.
10 MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN

1 THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.

2 (3) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL TRANSFER THE DONATION MONEY
3 FROM THE SALE OF FUND-RAISING PLATES RECOGNIZING WOMEN VETERANS TO
4 THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE DONATION MONEY TO THE
5 WOMEN VETERANS FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (2).

6 (4) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE MONEY IN THE WOMEN
7 VETERANS FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (2) ON A QUARTERLY BASIS
8 TO THE AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY.

9 (5) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL BE THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE
10 WOMEN VETERANS FUND FOR AUDITING PURPOSES.
