## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1177. (1) A child enrolling in a public or nonpublic school for the first time or, beginning in the 2002-2003-2014-2015 school year, enrolling in grade 6-7 for the first time shall submit 1 of the following:
  - (a) A statement signed by a physician that the child has been tested for and immunized or protected against diseases specified by the director of the department of community health.
  - (b) A statement signed by a parent or guardian to the effect that the child has not been immunized because of religious convictions or other objection to immunization.
  - (c) A statement signed by a physician that certifies that the child is in the process of complying with all immunization

- 2 (2) In addition, the parent or guardian of each child
- 3 enrolling in kindergarten for the first time shall submit a
- 4 statement signed by a district, county, or city health department
- 5 director stating that the child has been administered the
- 6 department of community health preschool vision screening test, or
- 7 signed by a licensed medical or osteopathic physician or a licensed
- 8 optometrist stating that the child's eyes have been examined during
- 9 the preschool years after age 3 and before initial entrance. A
- 10 vision test is not required if there is a statement signed by a
- 11 parent or guardian to the effect that the child cannot be submitted
- 12 to the test because of religious convictions.
- 13 (3) Not later than November 1 of each year, the administrator
- 14 of each school shall provide the director of the department of
- 15 community health with the immunization status of each pupil in
- 16 grades K through 12 who enrolled in the school for the first time,
- 17 or, beginning in the 2002-2003-2014-2015 school year, enrolled in
- 18 grade 6-7 in the school for the first time, between the immediately
- 19 preceding January 1 and the immediately preceding September 30, as
- 20 well as a vision report of each child entering kindergarten during
- 21 that time period. This information shall be transmitted through the
- 22 approved local full-time health department, if available, and shall
- 23 be on forms provided by the director of community health or
- 24 otherwise reported in a manner approved by the director of the
- 25 department of community health. Not later than February 1 of each
- 26 year, the administrator of each school shall provide an update to
- 27 the report due the previous November 1 to show the immunization

- 1 status of each pupil in grades K through 12 who enrolled in the
- 2 school for the first time, or, beginning in the 2002-2003-2014-2015
