SENATE BILL No. 273

March 19, 2013, Introduced by Senators EMMONS, BRANDENBURG, PAPPAGEORGE, BOOHER, SCHUITMAKER and JONES and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending sections 18201, 18211, 18223, 18233, and 18237 (MCL 333.18201, 333.18211, 333.18223, 333.18233, and 333.18237), section 18211 as amended by 2006 PA 395, section 18223 as amended by 2010 PA 121, section 18233 as amended by 1994 PA 234, and section 18237 as amended by 1998 PA 496.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 18201. (1) As used in this part:

- (a) "Psychologist" means an individual licensed under this article to engage in the practice of psychology.
- (A) "PRACTICE AS A PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATE" MEANS RENDERING SERVICES TO INDIVIDUALS, GROUPS, ORGANIZATIONS, OR THE PUBLIC THAT INVOLVE THE APPLICATION OF PRINCIPLES, METHODS, AND PROCEDURES OF UNDERSTANDING, PREDICTING, AND INFLUENCING BEHAVIOR FOR THE

- 1 PURPOSES OF THE DIAGNOSIS, PREVENTION, AMELIORATION, OR TREATMENT
- 2 OF MENTAL OR EMOTIONAL DISORDERS, DISABILITIES, OR BEHAVIORAL
- 3 ADJUSTMENT PROBLEMS BY MEANS OF PSYCHOTHERAPY, COUNSELING, BEHAVIOR
- 4 MODIFICATION, HYPNOSIS, BIOFEEDBACK TECHNIQUES, OR OTHER VERBAL OR
- 5 BEHAVIORAL MEANS. THE PRACTICE AS A PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATE DOES
- 6 NOT INCLUDE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (i) THE PRACTICE OF MEDICINE, SUCH AS PRESCRIBING DRUGS,
- 8 PERFORMING SURGERY, OR ADMINISTERING ELECTRO-CONVULSIVE THERAPY.
- 9 (ii) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS PART, THE
- 10 ADMINISTRATION, PRODUCTION, OR DISTRIBUTION OF WRITTEN OR VERBAL
- 11 PSYCHOLOGICAL TESTING, EVALUATIONS, OR REPORTS, OR THE
- 12 DOCUMENTATION OR DISTRIBUTION OF THE PSYCHOLOGICAL TESTING,
- 13 EVALUATIONS, OR REPORTS IN A CLINICAL RECORD.
- 14 (iii) THE PRACTICE OF APPLIED BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS UNLESS THE
- 15 INDIVIDUAL IS LICENSED OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED TO ENGAGE IN THE
- 16 PRACTICE OF APPLIED BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS UNDER ANOTHER PART OF THIS
- 17 ACT OR OTHER STATE LAW.
- 18 (b) "Practice of psychology" means the rendering SERVICES to
- 19 individuals, groups, organizations, or the public of services
- 20 involving THAT INVOLVE the application of principles, methods, and
- 21 procedures of understanding, predicting, and influencing behavior
- 22 for the purposes of the diagnosis, assessment related to diagnosis,
- 23 prevention, amelioration, or treatment of mental or emotional
- 24 disorders, disabilities or behavioral adjustment problems by means
- 25 of psychotherapy, counseling, behavior modification, hypnosis,
- 26 biofeedback techniques, psychological tests, or other verbal or
- 27 behavioral means. The practice of psychology shall DOES not include

- 1 the practice of medicine such as prescribing drugs, performing
- 2 surgery, or administering electro-convulsive therapy.
- 3 (C) "PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATE" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS
- 4 LICENSED OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO ENGAGE IN
- 5 THE PRACTICE AS A PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATE.
- 6 (D) "PSYCHOLOGIST" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LICENSED UNDER
- 7 THIS ARTICLE TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF PSYCHOLOGY.
- 8 (2) In addition to the definitions in this part, article 1
- 9 contains general definitions and principles of construction
- 10 applicable to all articles in this code and part 161 contains
- 11 definitions applicable to this part.
- 12 Sec. 18211. (1) A person AN INDIVIDUAL shall not engage in the
- 13 practice of psychology unless HE OR SHE IS licensed or otherwise
- 14 authorized by this article. BEGINNING ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF
- 15 RULES PROMULGATED UNDER SECTION 18223(3), AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL NOT
- 16 ENGAGE IN PRACTICE AS A PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATE UNLESS HE OR SHE IS
- 17 LICENSED OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED BY THIS ARTICLE.
- 18 (2) The following words, titles, or letters or a combination
- 19 thereof, with or without qualifying words or phrases, are
- 20 restricted in use only to those persons authorized under this part
- 21 to use the terms and in a way prescribed in this part: "consulting
- 22 psychologist", "psychologist", "psychological assistant",
- 23 "psychological examiner", "licensed psychologist", and—"limited
- 24 licensed psychologist", "PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATE", "LICENSED
- 25 PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATE", AND "LIMITED LICENSED PSYCHOLOGICAL
- 26 ASSOCIATE".
- 27 Sec. 18223. (1) The board shall promulgate rules requiring

- 1 that REQUIRE an individual WHO IS granted a license under this part
- 2 TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF PSYCHOLOGY, except as provided in
- 3 subsection (2), shall—TO meet both—ALL of the following
- 4 requirements:
- 5 (a) Been granted HE OR SHE HAS a doctoral degree in
- 6 psychology, or a doctoral degree in a closely related field, from a
- 7 regionally accredited or other college, university, or institution
- 8 approved by the board, which THAT included education and training
- 9 appropriate to the practice of psychology. Additionally, beginning
- 10 August 1, 2011, the
- 11 (B) HIS OR HER doctoral degree in psychology, or the doctoral
- 12 degree in a closely related field, shall be IS from a program that
- 13 has obtained the association of state and provincial psychology
- 14 boards' national register designation or has been—IS accredited by
- 15 the American psychological association or the Canadian
- 16 psychological association, or has obtained a similar designation
- 17 from or been-IS accredited by an entity approved by the board. For
- 18 purposes of the requirement added by the amendatory act that added
- 19 this sentence , a A program that is in the process of obtaining
- 20 this designation or becoming accredited as required in this
- 21 subdivision before August 1, 2011, and that obtains the designation
- 22 or becomes accredited on or before August 31, 2015, meets the
- 23 requirements of this subdivision.
- 24 (C) (b) Have not less than HE OR SHE HAS AT LEAST 1 year of
- 25 postdoctoral experience in the practice of psychology in an
- 26 organized health care setting or other arrangement, as established
- 27 by the board.

1 (2) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (4), THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY ON AND AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF RULES 2 3 PROMULGATED UNDER SUBSECTION (3). In addition to section 16182, the 4 board shall grant a limited license TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF 5 PSYCHOLOGY to an individual granted WHO HAS a master's degree in 6 psychology from a regionally accredited college, or university, or institution approved by the board, if the individual has education, 7 training, and experience appropriate to the practice of psychology, 8 9 as established by the board. Except for duties performed as an 10 employee of a governmental entity or of a nonprofit organization 11 serving benevolent and charitable purposes, THE BOARD SHALL PLACE 2 12 limitations shall be placed on a LIMITED license granted to an 13 individual under this subsection. The limitations shall require 14 supervision by a psychologist who has a license other than a 15 limited license and shall prohibit advertising or other 16 representation to the public which THAT will lead the public to 17 believe the individual is engaging in the practice of psychology. A 18 limited license granted under this subsection shall be renewed 19 pursuant to IS RENEWABLE UNDER part 161. An individual WHO IS 20 applying for a limited license pursuant to UNDER this subsection 21 shall MUST have 1 year of supervised postgraduate experience in an 22 organized health care setting or other arrangement, as established 23 by the board. The individual shall be supervised by a psychologist 24 who has a license other than a limited license, or if a 25 psychologist who has a license other than a limited license is not 26 available, by a psychologist who has at least a master's degree in 27 psychology and at least 3 years of experience in the practice of

- 1 psychology or by any other individual approved by the board. The
- 2 board shall issue a temporary license to the individual for the
- 3 purpose of obtaining the 1 year of postgraduate experience.
- 4 (3) ON OR BEFORE THE EXPIRATION OF 1 YEAR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE
- 5 DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SUBSECTION, THE BOARD
- 6 SHALL PROMULGATE RULES TO ESTABLISH AND ADMINISTER A LICENSURE
- 7 PROGRAM FOR PRACTICE AS A PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATE. BEGINNING ON THE
- 8 EFFECTIVE DATE OF RULES PROMULGATED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE
- 9 BOARD SHALL GRANT A LICENSE TO ENGAGE IN PRACTICE AS A
- 10 PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATE, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS
- 11 SECTION, TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING
- 12 REOUIREMENTS:
- 13 (A) HE OR SHE HAS A MASTER'S DEGREE IN PSYCHOLOGY FROM A
- 14 REGIONALLY ACCREDITED OR OTHER COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY, OR INSTITUTION
- 15 APPROVED BY THE BOARD, THE PREPARATION FOR WHICH INCLUDED EDUCATION
- 16 AND TRAINING APPROPRIATE TO PRACTICE AS A PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATE.
- 17 (B) HE OR SHE HAS AT LEAST 6,000 HOURS OF EXPERIENCE IN
- 18 PRACTICE AS A PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATE IN AN ORGANIZED HEALTH CARE
- 19 SETTING OR OTHER ARRANGEMENT, AS ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD. THE
- 20 BOARD SHALL ONLY RECOGNIZE HOURS THAT ARE ACCUMULATED IN NOT FEWER
- 21 THAN 3 YEARS OR MORE THAN 6 YEARS UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A
- 22 PSYCHOLOGIST WHO HAS A LICENSE OTHER THAN A LIMITED LICENSE.
- 23 HOWEVER, IF A PSYCHOLOGIST WHO HAS A LICENSE OTHER THAN A LIMITED
- 24 LICENSE IS NOT AVAILABLE, THE BOARD MAY AUTHORIZE A PSYCHOLOGICAL
- 25 ASSOCIATE WHO HAS A LICENSE OTHER THAN A LIMITED LICENSE, WHO HAS
- 26 AT LEAST A MASTER'S DEGREE IN PSYCHOLOGY, AND WHO HAS AT LEAST 3
- 27 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN PRACTICE AS A PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATE OF

- 1 PSYCHOTHERAPY TO PROVIDE THE SUPERVISION REQUIRED UNDER THIS
- 2 SUBDIVISION. THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A LIMITED LICENSE TO AN
- 3 INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE OTHER REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION FOR
- 4 THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING THE HOURS OF EXPERIENCE REQUIRED UNDER
- 5 THIS SUBDIVISION.
- 6 (C) SUBJECT TO STANDARDS INCLUDED IN THE RULES PROMULGATED
- 7 UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, HE OR SHE HAS PASSED THE EXAMINATION FOR THE
- 8 PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE OF PSYCHOLOGY AS DEVELOPED BY THE ASSOCIATION
- 9 OF STATE AND PROVINCIAL PSYCHOLOGY BOARDS.
- 10 (4) UNTIL 1 YEAR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE RULES
- 11 PROMULGATED UNDER SUBSECTION (3), THE BOARD SHALL GRANT A
- 12 PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATE LICENSE TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HELD A LIMITED
- 13 LICENSE TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF PSYCHOLOGY UNDER SUBSECTION
- 14 (2) ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE RULES PROMULGATED UNDER SUBSECTION
- 15 (3) OR, AT THE LIMITED LICENSEE'S OPTION, RENEW HIS OR HER LIMITED
- 16 LICENSE UNDER SUBSECTION (2).
- 17 (5) NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 16182, AN INDIVIDUAL GRANTED A
- 18 LICENSE TO ENGAGE IN PRACTICE AS A PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATE UNDER
- 19 THIS PART SHALL NOT ADMINISTER, PRODUCE, OR DISTRIBUTE WRITTEN OR
- 20 VERBAL PSYCHOLOGICAL TESTING, EVALUATIONS, OR REPORTS, OR DOCUMENT
- 21 OR DISTRIBUTE THE PSYCHOLOGICAL TESTING, EVALUATIONS, OR REPORTS IN
- 22 A CLINICAL RECORD UNLESS SUPERVISED AND COUNTERSIGNED BY A
- 23 PSYCHOLOGIST WHO HAS A LICENSE OTHER THAN A LIMITED LICENSE.
- 24 Sec. 18233. (1) In addition to the requirements of part 161,
- 25 the board may require **THAT** a licensee seeking renewal of a license
- 26 to MUST furnish the board with satisfactory evidence that during
- 27 the 2 years immediately preceding application for renewal the

- 1 licensee has attended continuing education courses or programs THAT
- 2 ARE DESIGNED TO FURTHER EDUCATE LICENSEES AND ARE approved by the
- 3 board. totaling not less than a THE BOARD BY RULE MAY ESTABLISH THE
- 4 MINIMUM number of hours established by rule of the board in OF
- 5 subjects related to the practice of psychology and designed to
- 6 further educate licensees.OR PRACTICE AS A PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATE,
- 7 AS APPROPRIATE, FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSES OR PROGRAMS

- 9 (2) As required under section 16204, the board shall
- 10 promulgate rules requiring each applicant for license renewal to
- 11 complete as part of the continuing education requirement of
- 12 subsection (1) an appropriate number of hours or courses in pain
- and symptom management.
- 14 Sec. 18237. A psychologist licensed or allowed to use that
- 15 title_LICENSEE under this part or an individual under his or her
- 16 supervision cannot be compelled to disclose confidential
- 17 information acquired from an individual consulting the psychologist
- 18 LICENSEE in his or her professional capacity if the information is
- 19 necessary to enable the psychologist LICENSEE to render services.
- 20 Information may be disclosed with the consent of the individual
- 21 consulting the psychologist LICENSEE, or if the individual
- 22 consulting the psychologist LICENSEE is a minor, with the consent
- 23 of the minor's guardian, pursuant to section 16222 if the
- 24 psychologist LICENSEE reasonably believes it is necessary to
- 25 disclose the information to comply with section 16222, or under
- 26 section 16281. In a contest on the admission of a deceased
- 27 individual's will to probate, an heir at law of the decedent,

- 1 whether a proponent or contestant of the will, and the personal
- 2 representative of the decedent may waive the privilege created by
- 3 this section.
