## **SENATE BILL No. 299**

April 10, 2013, Introduced by Senators WHITMER, WARREN, ANDERSON, YOUNG, BIEDA, SMITH and HOPGOOD and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 453, entitled "Elliott-Larsen civil rights act,"

(MCL 37.2101 to 37.2804) by adding section 202b.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 202B. (1) THE COMMISSION ON PAY EQUITY IS CREATED IN THE 2 DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL RIGHTS.
- 3 (2) THE COMMISSION IS COMPOSED OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:
- 4 (A) THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL RIGHTS OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE.
  - (B) THE DIRECTOR OF THE MICHIGAN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE.
    - (C) THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR:
- 9 (i) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MICHIGAN WOMEN'S COMMISSION.
- 10 (ii) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MICHIGAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE.
  - (iii) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MICHIGAN STATE AFL-CIO.

- 1 (iv) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED AUTO WORKERS.
- 2 (v) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SMALL BUSINESS ASSOCIATION OF
- 3 MICHIGAN.
- 4 (vi) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE NATIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR WOMEN,
- 5 MICHIGAN.
- 6 (vii) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MICHIGAN WOMEN'S STUDIES
- 7 ASSOCIATION.
- 8 (viii) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MICHIGAN FARM BUREAU.
- 9 (3) THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL RIGHTS OR HIS OR
- 10 HER DESIGNEE SHALL SERVE AS THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE COMMISSION ON
- 11 PAY EQUITY AND SHALL CONVENE THE MEETINGS OF THE COMMISSION, SET
- 12 THE AGENDA FOR ALL MEETINGS, AND PREPARE ALL MINUTES AND REPORTS OF
- 13 THE WORK OF THE COMMISSION.
- 14 (4) THE COMMISSION ON PAY EQUITY SHALL DEVELOP DEFINITIONS OF
- 15 COMPARABLE WAGES, USING THE CRITERIA OF COMPOSITE SKILLS,
- 16 RESPONSIBILITY, EFFORT, EDUCATION OR TRAINING, AND WORKING
- 17 CONDITIONS. THE COMMISSION SHALL HOLD MEETINGS AND HEARINGS AS
- 18 NECESSARY TO DEVELOP DEFINITIONS, MODELS, AND GUIDELINES FOR
- 19 EMPLOYERS AND EMPLOYEES ON PAY EQUITY AND TO FULFILL ITS OTHER
- 20 DUTIES.
- 21 (5) THE COMMISSION ON PAY EQUITY SHALL PRESENT ITS FINDINGS
- 22 AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE AND THE CLERK OF
- 23 THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE GOVERNOR, AND THE PUBLIC BY A
- 24 DATE NOT LATER THAN 1 YEAR AFTER THE GOVERNOR APPOINTS ITS MEMBERS.
- 25 (6) ALL MEETINGS OF THE COMMISSION ON PAY EQUITY ARE SUBJECT
- 26 TO THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 TO 15.275, AND
- 27 RECORDS AND DOCUMENTS OF THE COMMISSION ARE SUBJECT TO THE FREEDOM
