THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 7. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this act or in subsection (3), a person , firm, or corporation shall not engage in the business of electrical contracting unless the person , firm, or corporation has received from the board or from the appropriate municipality an electrical contractor's license.

(2) Except as otherwise provided in this act or in subsection (3), a person, other than a person licensed under this act and employed by and working under the direction of a holder of an electrical contractor's license, AN INDIVIDUAL shall not in any manner undertake to execute any electrical wiring UNLESS HE OR SHE
