## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 316. (1) A person who commits any of the following is guilty of first degree murder and shall be punished by imprisonment for life:
  - (a) Murder perpetrated by means of poison, lying in wait, or any other willful, deliberate, and premeditated killing.
  - (b) Murder committed in the perpetration of, or attempt to perpetrate, arson, criminal sexual conduct in the first, second, or third degree, child abuse in the first degree, a major controlled substance offense, robbery, carjacking, breaking and entering of a dwelling, home invasion in the first or second degree, larceny of any kind, extortion, kidnapping, vulnerable adult abuse in the
