SENATE BILL No. 430

June 13, 2013, Introduced by Senators CASPERSON, COLBECK, ROBERTSON, PAVLOV, BRANDENBURG, JONES, GREEN, KOWALL and PAPPAGEORGE and referred to the Committee on Economic Development.

A bill to amend 1996 PA 376, entitled "Michigan renaissance zone act," by amending section 3 (MCL 125.2683), as amended by 2010 PA 277, and by adding section 8i.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 3. As used in this act:

facilities or operations that transform, package, sort, or grade livestock or livestock products, agricultural commodities, or plants or plant products, excluding forest products, into goods that are used for intermediate or final consumption including goods for nonfood use, and surrounding property.

(B) "ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING FACILITY" MEANS 1 OR MORE FACILITIES OR OPERATIONS THAT MANUFACTURE OR ASSEMBLE FIREARMS,

- 12 negatively affected by the development of the international border
- 13 crossing and is unable to recover from the displacement or negative

- (ii) That is associated with international trade, shipping, or
- 16 freight hauling, including, but not limited to, all of the
- 17 following:
- 18 (A) Customs brokers.
- 19 (B) Distribution centers.
- 20 (C) Truck supply and repair.
- 21 (F) (d) "Development plan" means a written plan that addresses
- 22 the criteria in section 7 and includes all of the following:
- 23 (i) A map of the proposed renaissance zone that indicates the
- 24 geographic boundaries, the total area, and the present use and
- 25 conditions generally of the land and structures within those
- 26 boundaries.
- 27 (ii) Evidence of community support and commitment from

- 1 residential and business interests.
- 2 (iii) A description of the methods proposed to increase economic
- 3 opportunity and expansion, facilitate infrastructure improvement,
- 4 and identify job training opportunities.
- 5 (iv) Current social, economic, and demographic characteristics
- 6 of the proposed renaissance zone and anticipated improvements in
- 7 education, health, human services, public safety, and employment if
- 8 the renaissance zone is created.
- 9 (v) Any other information required by the board.
- 10 (G) (e) "Elected county executive" means the elected county
- 11 executive in a county organized under 1966 PA 293, MCL 45.501 to
- 12 45.521, or 1973 PA 139, MCL 45.551 to 45.573.
- (H) (f) "Eligible next Michigan business" means a business
- 14 engaged in the shipment of tangible personal property via
- 15 multimodal commerce; a supply chain business providing a majority
- 16 of its services to businesses engaged in the shipment of tangible
- 17 personal property, including inventory, via multimodal commerce; a
- 18 manufacturing or assembly facility receiving a majority of its
- 19 production components via multimodal commerce; a manufacturing or
- 20 assembly facility shipping a majority of products via multimodal
- 21 commerce; or a light manufacturing or assembly facility that
- 22 packages, kits, labels, or customizes products and ships those
- 23 products via multimodal commerce.
- 24 (I) (g) "Forest products processing facility" means 1 or more
- 25 facilities or operations that transform, package, sort, recycle, or
- 26 grade forest or paper products into goods that are used for
- 27 intermediate or final use or consumption or for the creation of

- 1 biomass or alternative fuels through the utilization of forest
- 2 products or forest residue, and surrounding property. Forest
- 3 products processing facility does not include an existing facility
- 4 or operation that is located in this state that relocates to a
- 5 renaissance zone for a forest products processing facility. Forest
- 6 products processing facility does not include a facility or
- 7 operation that engages primarily in retail sales.
- 8 (J) (h) "Local governmental unit" means a county, city,
- 9 village, township, or, for taxes levied after 2009, any other
- 10 taxing jurisdiction that levies an ad valorem property tax.
- 11 (K) (i) "Multimodal commerce" means the movement of products
- 12 or services via 2 or more of the following:
- 13 (i) Air.
- **14** (*ii*) Road.
- **15** (*iii*) Rail.
- 16 (iv) Water.
- 17 (l) "Next Michigan development corporation" means that term
- 18 as defined in section 3 of the next Michigan development act, 2010
- 19 PA 275, MCL 125.2953.
- 20 (M) (k)—"Next Michigan development district" means that term
- 21 as defined in section 3 of the next Michigan development act, 2010
- 22 PA 275, MCL 125.2953.
- 23 (N) $\frac{(l)}{(l)}$ "Next Michigan renaissance zone" means a renaissance
- 24 zone created under section 8h.
- 25 (O) (m) "Person" means an individual, partnership,
- 26 corporation, association, limited liability company, governmental
- 27 entity, or other legal entity.

- 1 (P) (n) "Qualified eligible next Michigan business" means an
- 2 eligible next Michigan business that has been certified in
- 3 accordance with section 8h.
- 4 (Q) (o) "Qualified local governmental unit" means either of
- 5 the following:
- 6 (i) A county.
- 7 (ii) A city, village, or township that contains an eligible
- 8 distressed area as defined in section 11 of the state housing

- 10 (R) (p) "Recovery zone" means a tool and die renaissance
- 11 recovery zone created in section 8d.
- (S) (q) "Renaissance zone" means a geographic area designated
- 13 under this act.
- 14 (T) (r) "Renewable energy facility" means a facility that
- 15 creates energy, fuels, or chemicals directly from the wind, the
- 16 sun, trees, grasses, biosolids, algae, agricultural commodities,
- 17 processed products from agricultural commodities, or residues from
- 18 agricultural processes, wood or forest processes, food production
- 19 and processing, or the paper products industry. Renewable energy
- 20 facility also includes a facility that creates energy, fuels, or
- 21 chemicals from solid biomass, animal wastes, or landfill gases.
- 22 Renewable energy facility also includes a facility that focuses on
- 23 research, development, or manufacturing of systems or components of
- 24 systems used to create energy, fuel, or chemicals from the items
- 25 described in this subdivision. Renewable energy facility also
- 26 includes a facility that focuses on research, development, or
- 27 manufacturing of systems or components of systems that involve the

- 12 SEC. 8I. (1) THE BOARD OF THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND DEFINED
- 13 IN SECTION 4 OF THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND ACT, 1984 PA 270, MCL
- 14 125.2004, MAY DESIGNATE UP TO 5 ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING
- 15 RENAISSANCE ZONES FOR ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING FACILITIES WITHIN
- 16 THIS STATE IN 1 OR MORE CITIES, VILLAGES, OR TOWNSHIPS IF THAT
- 17 CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP OR COMBINATION OF CITIES, VILLAGES, OR
- 18 TOWNSHIPS CONSENTS TO THE CREATION OF AN ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING
- 19 RENAISSANCE ZONE FOR AN ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING FACILITY WITHIN
- 20 THEIR BOUNDARIES. AN ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING RENAISSANCE ZONE
- 21 FOR AN ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING FACILITY SHALL HAVE A DURATION OF
- 22 RENAISSANCE ZONE STATUS FOR A PERIOD OF 15 YEARS.

- 25 SECTION SHALL BE 1 CONTINUOUS DISTINCT GEOGRAPHIC AREA.
- 26 (3) THE BOARD MAY REVOKE THE DESIGNATION OF ALL OR A PORTION
- 27 OF AN ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING RENAISSANCE ZONE FOR AN ARMS-

- 1 RELATED MANUFACTURING FACILITY IF THE BOARD DETERMINES THAT THE
- 2 ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING FACILITY DOES 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING
- 3 IN AN ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING RENAISSANCE ZONE DESIGNATED UNDER
- 4 THIS SECTION:
- 5 (A) FAILS TO COMMENCE OPERATION.
- 6 (B) CEASES OPERATION.
- 7 (C) FAILS TO COMMENCE CONSTRUCTION OR RENOVATION WITHIN 1 YEAR
- 8 FROM THE DATE THE ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING RENAISSANCE ZONE FOR
- 9 THE ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING FACILITY IS DESIGNATED.
- 10 (4) THE BOARD SHALL CONSIDER ALL OF THE FOLLOWING WHEN
- 11 DESIGNATING AN ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING RENAISSANCE ZONE FOR AN
- 12 ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING FACILITY:
- 13 (A) THE ECONOMIC IMPACT ON LOCAL SUPPLIERS WHO SUPPLY RAW
- 14 MATERIALS, GOODS, AND SERVICES TO THE ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING
- 15 FACILITY.
- 16 (B) THE CREATION OF JOBS RELATIVE TO THE EMPLOYMENT BASE OF
- 17 THE COMMUNITY RATHER THAN THE STATIC NUMBER OF JOBS CREATED.
- 18 (C) THE VIABILITY OF THE PROJECT.
- 19 (D) THE ECONOMIC IMPACT ON THE COMMUNITY IN WHICH THE ARMS-
- 20 RELATED MANUFACTURING FACILITY IS LOCATED.
- 21 (5) THE BOARD SHALL REQUIRE A DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN
- 22 THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND AND THE ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING
- 23 FACILITY.
- 24 (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT" MEANS A
- 25 WRITTEN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND AND THE ARMS-
- 26 RELATED MANUFACTURING FACILITY THAT INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED
- 27 TO, ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1 (A) A REQUIREMENT THAT THE ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING FACILITY
- 2 COMPLY WITH ALL STATE AND LOCAL LAWS.
- 3 (B) A REQUIREMENT THAT THE ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING FACILITY
- 4 REPORT ANNUALLY TO THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND ON ALL OF THE
- 5 FOLLOWING:
- 6 (i) THE AMOUNT OF CAPITAL INVESTMENT MADE AT THE FACILITY.
- 7 (ii) THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS EMPLOYED AT THE FACILITY AT THE
- 8 BEGINNING AND END OF THE REPORTING PERIOD AS WELL AS THE NUMBER OF
- 9 INDIVIDUALS TRANSFERRED TO THE FACILITY FROM ANOTHER FACILITY OWNED
- 10 BY THE ARMS-RELATED MANUFACTURING FACILITY.
- 11 (iii) THE PERCENTAGE OF RAW MATERIALS PURCHASED IN THIS STATE.
- 12 (C) ANY OTHER CONDITIONS OR REQUIREMENTS REASONABLY REQUIRED
- 13 BY THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND.
