A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961," by amending section 6094 (MCL 600.6094).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 6094. (1) Whenever any SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (4), IF A

 final judgment is obtained ENTERED against the A school district,
