

# SENATE BILL No. 464

September 10, 2013, Introduced by Senators WARREN, HUNTER, HANSEN, HOPGOOD, ANANICH, ANDERSON, GREGORY and HOOD and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 453, entitled  
"Elliott-Larsen civil rights act,"  
by amending the title and section 302 (MCL 37.2302), the title as  
amended by 1992 PA 258.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

### TITLE

An act to define civil rights; to prohibit discriminatory  
practices, policies, and customs in the exercise of those rights  
based upon religion, race, color, national origin, age, sex,  
height, weight, familial ~~status~~, or marital status, **OR**  
**BREASTFEEDING**; to preserve the confidentiality of records regarding  
arrest, detention, or other disposition in which a conviction does  
not result; to prescribe the powers and duties of the civil rights  
commission and the department of civil rights; to provide remedies  
and penalties; to provide for fees; and to repeal ~~certain~~ acts and

1 parts of acts.

2 Sec. 302. Except where permitted by law, a person shall not:

3 (a) Deny ~~an individual~~ the full and equal enjoyment of the  
4 goods, services, facilities, privileges, advantages, or  
5 accommodations of a place of public accommodation or public service  
6 **TO AN INDIVIDUAL** because of religion, race, color, national origin,  
7 age, sex, or marital status **OR TO A WOMAN BECAUSE SHE IS**  
8 **BREASTFEEDING A CHILD.**

9 (b) Print, circulate, post, mail, or otherwise cause to be  
10 published a statement, advertisement, notice, or sign ~~which~~ **THAT**  
11 indicates that the full and equal enjoyment of the goods, services,  
12 facilities, privileges, advantages, or accommodations of a place of  
13 public accommodation or public service will be refused, withheld  
14 from, or denied an individual because of religion, race, color,  
15 national origin, age, sex, or marital status ~~—or~~ **REFUSED, WITHHELD**  
16 **FROM, OR DENIED A WOMAN BECAUSE SHE IS BREASTFEEDING A CHILD;** that  
17 an individual's patronage of or presence at a place of public  
18 accommodation is objectionable, unwelcome, unacceptable, or  
19 undesirable because of religion, race, color, national origin, age,  
20 sex, or marital status; **OR THAT A WOMAN'S PATRONAGE OF OR PRESENCE**  
21 **AT A PLACE OF PUBLIC ACCOMMODATION IS OBJECTIONABLE, UNWELCOME,**  
22 **UNACCEPTABLE, OR UNDESIRABLE BECAUSE SHE IS BREASTFEEDING A CHILD.**
