## **SENATE BILL No. 501**

September 17, 2013, Introduced by Senators ANDERSON, HOPGOOD, ANANICH, JONES, BIEDA, JOHNSON, WHITMER, HUNTER, GREGORY, HOOD and YOUNG and referred to the Committee on Families, Seniors and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 462k.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 462K. (1) A PERSON WHO KNOWS THAT ANOTHER PERSON IS BEING
- 2 SUBJECTED TO A VIOLATION OF THIS CHAPTER SHALL IMMEDIATELY REPORT
- 3 THAT VIOLATION TO A POLICE AGENCY. THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY
- 4 IF THE PERSON IS NOT ABLE TO IMMEDIATELY REPORT THE VIOLATION
- 5 PROVIDED THAT HE OR SHE IMMEDIATELY REPORTS THE VIOLATION WHEN ABLE
- 6 TO DO SO.
- 7 (2) THE REQUIREMENTS FOR REPORTING A VIOLATION OF THIS CHAPTER
- 8 ARE MET IF EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING APPLIES:
- 9 (A) THE PERSON CONTACTS A 9-1-1 EMERGENCY OPERATOR AND REPORTS
- 10 THE VIOLATION.

(B) THE PERSON CONTACTS THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE USING

- 1 THE TOLL-FREE NUMBER ESTABLISHED BY THAT DEPARTMENT UNDER THE HUMAN

- 3 (3) THE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION INCLUDE AN
- 4 ANONYMOUS REPORT IF THE PERSON REPORTS SUFFICIENT INFORMATION TO
- 5 IDENTIFY THE VICTIM AND NATURE OF THE OFFENSE.
- 6 (4) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
- 7 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS OR
- 8 A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.
- 9 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "POLICE AGENCY" MEANS ANY OF THE
- 10 FOLLOWING ENTITIES HAVING JURISDICTION OF THE OFFENSE:
- 11 (A) THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE.
- 12 (B) A COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE.
- 13 (C) THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF A VILLAGE, CITY, OR TOWNSHIP.
- 14 (D) THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE, COLLEGE, OR
- 15 UNIVERSITY.
- 16 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 17 unless Senate Bill No. 499
- of the 97th Legislature is enacted into law.
