

SENATE BILL No. 555

September 26, 2013, Introduced by Senators JONES, PROOS, MARLEAU, ROBERTSON, NOFS and SCHUITMAKER and referred to the Committee on Banking and Financial Institutions.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled
"Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"
(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 1024.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 1024. (1) A RETAILER SHALL WORK WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF
2 HUMAN SERVICES AND WITH PERSONS THAT PROVIDE AUTOMATIC TELLER
3 MACHINE SERVICES ON THE RETAILER'S PREMISES TO PREVENT AN
4 INDIVIDUAL'S ACCESS TO FAMILY INDEPENDENCE PROGRAM ASSISTANCE BY
5 ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFER OR WITHDRAWAL FROM AN AUTOMATIC TELLER
6 MACHINE ON THE RETAILER'S PREMISES. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION
7 ONLY, A RETAILER DOES NOT INCLUDE A RETAIL GROCERY STORE THAT SELLS
8 OR OFFERS TO SELL STAPLE FOODS TO CONSUMERS FOR OFF-PREMISES
9 CONSUMPTION IN ADDITION TO ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR.

10 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

11 (A) "FAMILY INDEPENDENCE PROGRAM ASSISTANCE" MEANS THAT TERM

1 AS DEFINED IN SECTION 57 OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE ACT, 1939 PA 280,
2 MCL 400.57.

3 (B) "STAPLE FOODS" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 3 OF
4 THE FOOD AND NUTRITION ACT OF 2008, 7 USC 2011.
