(MCL 722.951 to 722.960) by adding section 4e.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 4E. BEFORE DETERMINING PLACEMENT OF A CHILD IN ITS CARE,
- 2 A SUPERVISING AGENCY SHALL GIVE SPECIAL CONSIDERATION TO
- 3 INFORMATION THAT A CHILD MAY BE THE VICTIM OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING.
- 4 THE SUPERVISING AGENCY MAY FIND THAT REUNIFICATION, ADOPTION, OR
- 5 OTHER TRADITIONAL FOSTER CARE SERVICES MAY NOT BE SUITABLE FOR THE
- 6 CHILD WHO IS A VICTIM OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND MAY DETERMINE AND
- PROVIDE OTHER NECESSARY SERVICES FOR THIS CHILD.
