

SENATE BILL No. 635

October 22, 2013, Introduced by Senator PROOS and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding sections 21334 and 21736.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 21334. (1) IF MEDICAL OR DENTAL CARE IS PROVIDED TO A
2 HOME FOR THE AGED RESIDENT ON THE PREMISES OF THE HOME FOR THE
3 AGED, THE HOME FOR THE AGED SHALL HAVE A PRIVATE EXAMINATION ROOM
4 FOR THE PURPOSE OF MEDICAL OR DENTAL EXAMINATION AND TREATMENT.

5 (2) THE HOME FOR THE AGED SHALL USE AN EXAMINATION ROOM
6 REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE MEDICAL AND
7 DENTAL EXAMINATION AND TREATMENT OF RESIDENTS AND SHALL KEEP THE
8 ROOM SEPARATE FROM COMMON AREAS, DINING FACILITIES, PATIENT ROOMS,
9 AND RESTROOMS. THE EXAMINATION ROOM MUST HAVE A DOOR OR OTHER MEANS
10 OF PREVENTING THE ENTRY OF UNAUTHORIZED INDIVIDUALS.

11 (3) THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROMULGATE RULES OR ADOPT GUIDELINES

1 FOR EXAMINATION ROOMS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION.

2 SEC. 21736. (1) IF MEDICAL OR DENTAL CARE IS PROVIDED TO A
3 NURSING HOME PATIENT ON THE PREMISES OF THE NURSING HOME, THE
4 NURSING HOME SHALL HAVE A PRIVATE EXAMINATION ROOM FOR THE PURPOSE
5 OF MEDICAL OR DENTAL EXAMINATION AND TREATMENT.

6 (2) THE NURSING HOME SHALL USE AN EXAMINATION ROOM REQUIRED
7 UNDER SUBSECTION (1) EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE MEDICAL AND DENTAL
8 EXAMINATION AND TREATMENT OF RESIDENTS AND SHALL KEEP THE ROOM
9 SEPARATE FROM COMMON AREAS, DINING FACILITIES, PATIENT ROOMS, AND
10 RESTROOMS. THE EXAMINATION ROOM MUST HAVE A DOOR OR OTHER MEANS OF
11 PREVENTING THE ENTRY OF UNAUTHORIZED INDIVIDUALS.

12 (3) THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROMULGATE RULES OR ADOPT GUIDELINES
13 FOR EXAMINATION ROOMS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION.
